FIRST AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the Amended and Restated Agreement (R2020-1359) dated September 15, 2025 ("Agreement"), is made as of September 9, 2025, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County"), and Palms West Hospital Limited Partnership d/b/a HCA Florida Palms West Hospital (formerly d/b/a Palms West Hospital), a foreign limited partnership license to do business in the State of Florida ("Participant"), with a Federal Tax ID number of 62-1694178.

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the County and Participant agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the Agreement is renewed beginning on September 15, 2025, and continuing through September 14, 2030, pursuant to the exercise of the first renewal option for five (5) years.
- 2. Section 21 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 21: NON-DISCRIMINATION

The County is committed to assuring equal opportunity in the award of contracts and complies with all laws prohibiting discrimination. Pursuant to Palm Beach County Resolution R2025-0748, as may be amended, the Participant warrants and represents that throughout the term of the Agreement, including any renewals thereof, if applicable, all of its employees are treated equally during employment without regard to race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, or genetic information. Failure to meet this requirement shall be considered default of the Agreement.

SECTION 27: E-VERIFY - EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

27.01 Participant warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov), and uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of the Participant's contractors and subcontractors performing any duties and obligations under this Agreement are registered with and use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

27.02 County shall terminate this Agreement if it has a good faith belief that Participant has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.

SECTION 28: DISCLOSURE OF FOREIGN GIFTS AND CONTRACTS WITH FOREIGN COUNTRIES OF CONCERN

Pursuant to F.S. 286.101, as may be amended, by entering into this Contract or performing any work in furtherance thereof, the Participant certifies that it has disclosed any current or prior interest of, any contract with, or any grant or gift received from a foreign country of concern where such interest, contract, or grant or gift has a value of \$50,000 or more and such interest existed at any time or such contract or grant or gift was received or in force at any time during the previous five (5) years.

SECTION 29: HUMAN TRAFFICKING AFFIDAVIT

Participant warrants and represents that it does not use coercion for labor or services as defined in section 787.06, Florida Statutes. Participant has executed Exhibit "A", Nongovernmental Entity Human Trafficking Affidavit, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

3. Except as modified by this First Amendment, the Agreement remains unmodified and in full force and effect in accordance with the terms thereof and is hereby ratified and confirmed by the Participant and County.
