I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: a Term Extension Memorandum to an Interlocal Grant Agreement (Agreement) with the Solid Waste Authority of Palm Beach County (SWA) for \$50,000 for the demolition and removal of the Haverhill Park Racquetball Courts, extending the term from September 30, 2025 to September 30, 2026.

Summary: On November 23, 2022, the Parks and Recreation Department (Parks) submitted a SWA 2022 Blighted and Distressed Property Cleanup and Beautification Grant Application (Application). The Application requested \$50,000 in funding to cover the cost of the demolition of the Haverhill Park racquetball courts. Grant funding was awarded and the Agreement (R2023-0605) was approved by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on May 2, 2023. The original grant term was from May 2, 2023 to February 28, 2024. Due to project delays, SWA approved a grant extension extending the completion date from February 28, 2024 to September 30, 2024 (R2024-0183). Subsequently, a second extension (R2024-1119) was approved, further extending the completion date to September 30, 2025. Due to further time delays, SWA has granted an additional one (1)-year time extension through September 30, 2026. There are no other changes to the terms of the Agreement as a result of this extension. These courts are well utilized and new racquetball courts will be constructed after the existing ones are demolished. District 2 (AH)

Background and Justification: Haverhill Park is a 23 acre community level park located within the Town of Haverhill. The Park opened to the public in 1979 and features an exercise course with 20 fitness stations, picnic facilities, playground, two (2) tennis courts, four (4) basketball courts, softball field, grass volleyball court and four (4) racquetball courts. This extension will allow the County to complete the project.
