I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: the Objection Letter for the City of Boynton Beach Palmyra and Bamboo Lane Annexations for the Mayor's signature, provide update on previous Board direction and seek any additional direction.

Summary: At its September 25, 2025, meeting, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) directed staff to object to the City of Boynton Beach's (the "City") proposed annexations of Palmyra and Bamboo Lane and prepare a letter for Board review and consideration at the September 30, 2025 BCC Workshop. Staff will be presenting the Objection Letter and Legal Opinion to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on the Palmyra and Bamboo Lane Voluntary Annexations. **Districts 2 and 4** (DL)

Background and Policy Issue: Florida Statutes 171.044, Voluntary Annexation allows the owner or owners of real property in an unincorporated area of a county which is contiguous to a municipality and reasonably compact to petition the County to annex into the City of Boynton Beach. The purpose of the Voluntary Annexation statute is to give landowners who want to be annexed a way of doing so.

Palm Beach County has received a filing for voluntary annexation from the City of Boynton Beach (August 4, 2025). The City seeks to voluntarily annex approximately 39.37 acres of land at the southwest corner of Hypoluxo Road and Lawrence Road (Palmyra) and approximately 4.6 acres of land approximately 570 feet south of the intersection of Federal Highway and Old Dixie Highway on the east side of Federal Highway (Bamboo Lane). The City has scheduled its adoption hearing on October 7, 2025. The filing includes two petitions which include sworn statements from the City Manager, acting as the Attorney in Fact, for the landowners through the water service agreements.

As none of the powers of attorney at issue contain language indicating that they run with the land or bind subsequent purchasers or agents, they cannot be used by the City as the basis for filing a voluntary petition on behalf of landowners, most of whom never signed the power of attorney. As such, the County objects to the proposed annexations, and if approved, this letter will be included in the record for the hearings on the final adoption of the annexation ordinances and in the notices to all landowners within the Palmyra and Bamboo Lane annexation petitions. Should the City adopt the annexation ordinances, the County reserves the right to pursue the remedies available to it under Chapter 171, Florida Statutes.

RE: City of Boynton Beach Bamboo and Palmyra Petitions for Voluntary Annexation

Dear Mr. Dugger:

At its September 25, 2025, meeting, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners directed staff to object to the City of Boynton Beach's (the "City") proposed annexations of Bamboo Lane and Palmyra. As such, please accept this letter as Palm Beach County's objection to the proposed annexations and please include this letter in the record of the hearing on the adoption of the proposed annexation ordinances.

The City is processing these annexations as voluntary under section 171.044, Fla. Stat. Section 171.044(2) requires any petition for voluntary annexation to have "the signatures of all owners of property in the area proposed to be annexed." The petitions that the City forwarded to the County do not have these signatures. Instead, the petitions are each signed by the City's Manager as Attorney in Fact for the current owners of the properties in the annexation area. For the reasons set forth below, such a petition does not comply with the Section 171.044(2) requirement that the petition bear the signatures of all property owners in the annexation area.

Bamboo Lane

For the Bamboo annexation, the area includes fifteen (15) properties. The petitions, as set forth above, are signed by the City Manager as Attorney in Fact for the landowners and includes references to the Official Records Book and Page numbers of documents titled "Summary of Agreement for Water and Wastewater Service Outside the City Limits, Covenant for Annexation, and Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney." This recorded summary references an "Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney" signed by the landowner at that time. However, the power of attorney itself was not recorded in the Official Records. Rather, the City provided copies of those unrecorded powers of attorney along with the corresponding "Agreement for Water and Wastewater Service Outside the City Limits and Covenant for Annexation" with its petitions. The County has determined that of the fifteen properties in the annexation area, five (5) of the current landowners have not signed the "Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney," which was signed by the prior owners of the properties.

As for the documents themselves, the County does not believe that they are sufficient to allow the power of attorney to run with the land, even if such a provision is legal. First, the only document recorded in the Official Records was the "Summary of Agreement for Water and Wastewater Service Outside the City Limits, Covenant for Annexation, and Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney."

This recorded summary references an "Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney," but it does not state that the power of attorney runs with the land and does not have the power of attorney attached. Rather, it states "THAT this document is recorded in the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida and shall run with the above-described real property, be binding on the Owner and all subsequent transferees, grantees, heirs, successors and assigns." Since this was the only document recorded in the Official Records, this is the only document a subsequent purchaser would see in a title insurance policy or title report. Since this document does not have the power of attorney attached, and does not state that the power of attorney shall run with the land and be binding on subsequent purchasers, it is not sufficient to put subsequent purchasers on notice that a power of attorney binds them and cannot justify using such power of attorney to allow the City to sign a voluntary petition for annexation on behalf of a subsequent landowner.

Second, the "Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney" itself does not have any language stating that it runs with the land or is binding on the heirs or grantees of the landowner. It simply states that the individual signing it has given the City of Boynton Beach the power to initiate, maintain, and complete a voluntary petition for annexation" on the signer's behalf. The corresponding Agreement for Water does have language stating that the owner is to notify all subsequent purchasers of the power of attorney, and that the unrecorded agreement and power of attorney are to run with the land. However, this is not enough to actually bind the subsequent purchasers since neither the agreement, nor the power of attorney was recorded in the Official Records of the County. Because of this, the only document the subsequent purchasers had to rely on was the "Summary of Agreement for Water and Wastewater Service Outside the City Limits, Covenant for Annexation, and Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney." As set forth above, this document lacks sufficient information to put a subsequent purchaser on notice that it is bound by a power of attorney it did not sign.

For these reasons, the Bamboo Lane annexation does not comply with the requirements of section 171.044(2) because it does not bear the signatures of all of the landowners within the annexation area.

Palmyra

The Palmyra annexation is for 123 properties. In this case there is one petition for all 123 properties signed by the City Manager as Attorney in Fact for these property owners. The petition refers to several documents recorded in the Official Records of Palm Beach County. However, some of these documents do not apply to properties within the proposed annexation area.

For instance, the petition references an "Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney" and a "Water Service Agreement" for Sharon and Patrick Robinson recorded in Official Records Book 13660, Page 1215. However, the only document recorded at that location is an "Agreement for Water Service Outside the City Limits and Covenant for Annexation" dated April 4, 2002, which does not include any legal description of the property that it is meant to bind. Furthermore, it does not have a power of attorney attached. In any event, the corresponding power of attorney was recorded, at book 13660, Page 1219.

However, much like the powers of attorneys for Bamboo Lane, this one does not state that it runs with the land or is binding on subsequent purchasers. However, most importantly, the legal description attached to this power of attorney pertains to a parcel identified by PCN 00-43-45-18-00-000-7150. This property is situated on Tucks Road, located south of Gateway Boulevard and east of Lawrence Road. It is nowhere near Palmyra, which is located south of Hypoluxo Road. It is also not adjacent to the City's boundaries. Therefore, the County cannot speculate why this was included in the petition to annex Palmyra. This also applies to the documents referenced for John and Brenda Orrico and Phillip and Cheryl Hartnett.

Notwithstanding these mistakes, the City alleges that the documents executed by Dahlgren, recorded in Book 13660, Page 1433, and the documents executed by Bauer, recorded in Book 13660, Page 1453, the original owners of the unsubdivided property, give the City the authority to execute the voluntary petition for annexation on behalf of all the landowners of the subdivided lots within Palmyra. They do not.

The Dahlgren "Agreement for Water Service Outside the City Limits and Covenant for Annexation" is dated March 20, 2002. It is between the Dahlgren Trust, as the then-owner of the land, Continental Homes of Florida, Inc., the contract purchaser of Dahlgren's land, and the City of Boynton Beach. The agreement is for 120.5 equivalent residential water connections to be provided by the City. Like the agreement for the Bamboo Lane properties, this agreement includes language that Dahlgren will execute a power of attorney granting the City the authority to pursue a voluntary annexation petition on their behalf. It also obligates Dahlgren to notify all subsequent purchasers of the property of the power of attorney and the City's power to annex the land voluntarily. It also states that the agreement runs with the land. In addition, the entire agreement "will be null and void, if, Continental Homes of Florida, Inc. has not acquired the property by July 22, 2002." In other words, the contract is contingent on Dahlgren conveying title to Continental no later than July 22, 2002. The Bauer agreement is identical to the Dahlgren agreement. To the best of the County's knowledge, Dahlgren and Bauer conveyed title to Continental prior to July 22, 2002. Both Bauer and Dahlgren also signed an "Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney."

Just like the powers of attorney for the Bamboo Lane annexation, these powers of attorney granted the City the power to pursue a voluntary annexation petition on their behalf. However, they do not have any language stating that they are meant to run with the land. Importantly, these powers of attorney have language conditioning their effectiveness "until and unless the Grantee transfers legal fee title to the property to CONTINENTAL HOMES OF FLORIDA, INC., or its successors or assigns in accordance with the terms of the contract for sale. Upon such transfer of title, this Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney shall be automatically transferred and assumed by CONTINENTAL HOMES OF FLORIDA, INC."

The problem is that by its terms, the power of attorney is not effective until after the Grantee (Dahlgren and Bauer) transfers title to Continental. As such, Continental should have signed the power of attorney, not Dahlgren and Bauer,

since at the time the power of attorney took effect, they, being Dahlgren and Bauer, no longer had fee title to the property and could therefore no longer bind the property.

In addition, even if the power of attorney is found to be valid, there is no legal support that these two powers of attorney granted by the owners of the unsubdivided land can bind all of the subsequent purchasers of the subdivided lots. Powers of attorney are personal between the principal and the agent, and courts strictly construe their terms to ascertain the intent of the principal. *Manor Oaks, Inc. v. Campbell*, 276 So. 3d 830, 833 (Fla. 4th DCA 2019). And as discussed above, these powers of attorney do not have any language indicating that they were to be extended from the two original owners to 123 subsequent owners.

As none of the powers of attorney at issue contain language indicating that they run with the land or bind subsequent purchasers or agents, they cannot be used by the City as the basis for filing a voluntary petition on behalf of landowners, most of whom never signed the power of attorney. The purpose of the Voluntary Annexation statute is to give landowners who want to be annexed a way of doing so. This is a perversion of that process, as it "voluntarily" forces annexation on landowners who may not want to be annexed. Finally, please note that the City cannot threaten to turn off or turn off the water services it provides to the affected landowners should they choose to object to the proposed annexations. Edris v. Sebring Utilities Commission, 237 So. 2d 585, 587 (Fla. 2d DCA 1970) (holding that a public utility corporation, including municipalities that provide utilities, cannot refuse to render service because of some collateral matter not related to that service). As such, the County objects to the proposed annexations and would like this letter to be included in the record for the hearings on the final adoption of the annexation ordinances. Should the City adopt the annexation ordinances, the County reserves the right to pursue the remedies available to it under Chapter 171, Florida Statutes.

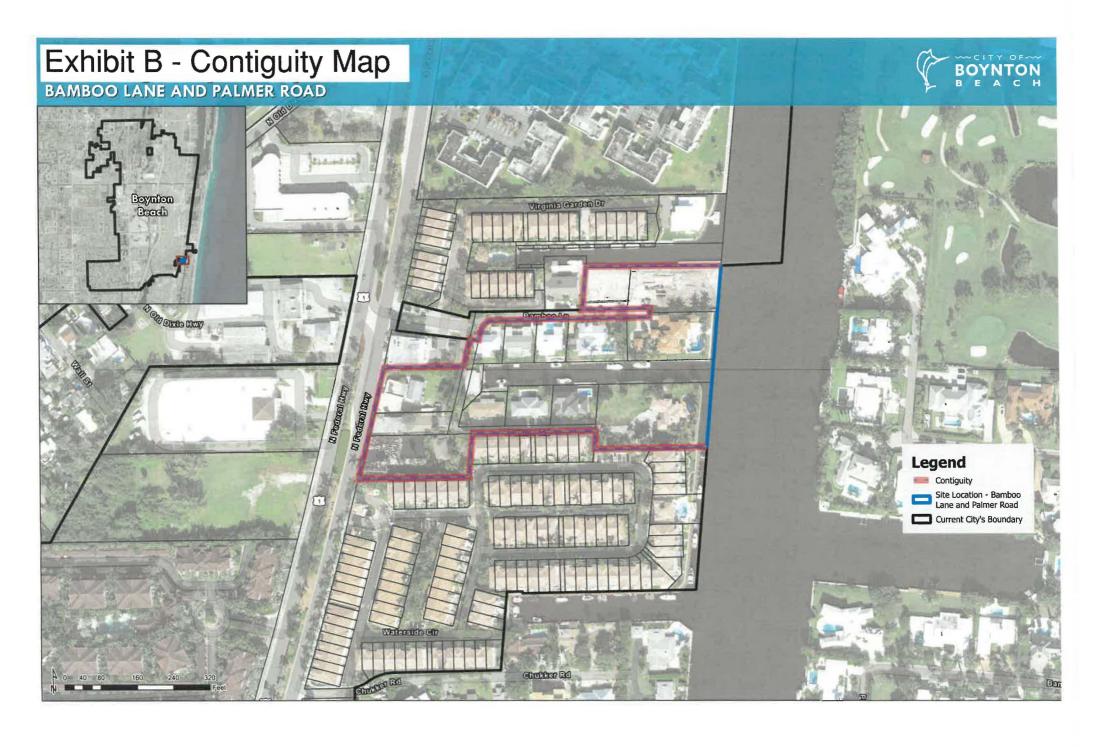

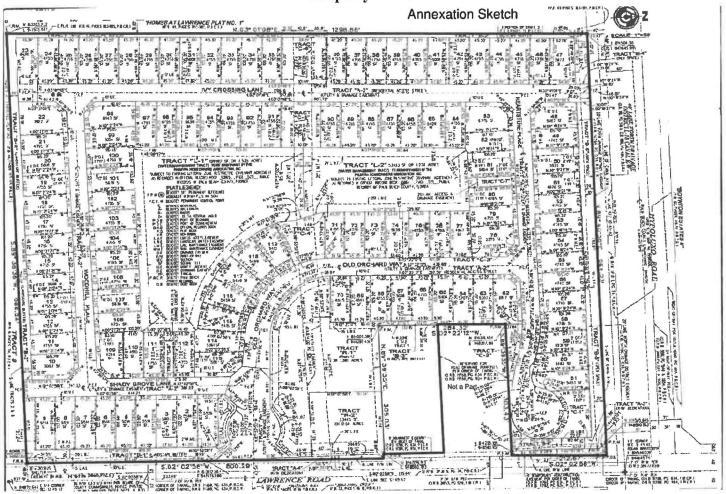

AGREEMENT FOR WATER SERVICE OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS AND COVENANT FOR ANNEXATION

THIS AGREEMENT made on this day of April 2002 by and between Sharon is Patrick Robinson hereinafter called the "Customer", and the CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, hereinafter called the "City".

WHEREAS, Customer owns real property outside of the jurisdictional limits of the City of Boynton Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Customer has requested that the City of Boynton Beach, Florida provide water service to the property owned by Customer; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boynton beach has the ability to provide water service to Customer's property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boynton Beach has a policy which conditions the grant of water services outside of its jurisdictional limits on annexation of the property to be serviced into the City at the earliest practicable time.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the privilege of receiving water service from the Municipal Water System and the mutual covenants expressed herein, the City of Boynton Beach and the Customer, his heirs, successors and assigns, agree as follows:

- The City agrees to provide Customer with water service from its Municipal Water System to service the real property described as follows and which Customer represents is owned by Customer: (Exhibit A)
- 2. The Customer and the City hereby agree that there are 1.4 Equivalent Residential Connections which City shall service.
- 3. The Customer agrees to pay all costs and fees of engineering, material, labor, installation and inspection of the facilities as required by the City of Boynton Beach Code of Ordinances or Land Development regulations to provide service to the

Customer's premises. The Customer shall be responsible for installation in conformance with all codes, rules and regulations applicable to the installation and maintenance of water service lines upon the Customer's premises. All such lines shall be approved by the Director of Utilities and subject to inspection by the City Engineers. The City shall have the option of either requiring the Customer to perform the work necessary to conform the lines or the City may have the work performed on behalf of the Customer, in which case the Customer will pay in advance all estimated costs thereof. In the event the City has such work performed, the Customer will also advance such additional funds as may be necessary to pay the total actual costs incurred by the City.

- 4. Any water main extension made pursuant to this Agreement shall be used only by the Customer, unless written consent is granted by the City of Boynton Beach for other parties to connect. All connections shall be made in accordance with the Codes and regulations of Boynton Beach.
- 5. Title to all mains, extensions and other facilities extended from the City Water Distribution System to and including the metered service to Customer shall be vested in the City exclusively unless otherwise conveyed or abandoned to the property owner.
- 6. The Customer agrees to pay all charges, deposits and rates for service and equipment in connection with water service outside the City limits applicable under City Ordinances and rate schedules which are applicable which may be changed from time to time.
- 7. Any rights-of-way or easements necessary to accommodate the connections shall be provided by the Customer to the City.
- 8. The Customer shall, contemporaneously execute and deliver to the City an Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney granting to the City the power and authority to execute and advance on behalf of the Customer a voluntary petition for annexation. Customer covenants that it shall cooperate with the City and not raise opposition or challenge to such annexation if and when annexation is initiated. The property shall be subject to annexation at the option of the City at any time the property is eligible under any available means or method for annexation. Customer will inform any and all assigns or purchasers of any or part of this property of this covenant and of the irrevocable special power of attorney, but Customer's failure to provide such notice shall not constitute a defense or bar to the City's rights as set forth herein. The Customer acknowledges that the consideration of initially connecting to the City's water supply is sufficient to support the grant of the power of attorney any subsequent disconnection or lack of service shall in no way impair the power of attorney nor constitute a diminution or lack of consideration.
- 9. The Customer acknowledges that this covenant regarding annexation is intended to be and is hereby made a covenant running with the land described in paragraph 1 above. This Agreement and the power of attorney referenced herein is to be recorded in the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, and the Customer

and all subsequent transferee, grantees, heirs or assigns of Customer shall be binding on the Customer and all successors and assigns.

- 10. It is agreed that the City shall have no liability in the event there is a reduction, impairment or termination in water service to be provided under this Agreement due to any prohibitions, restrictions, limitations or requirements of local, regional, State or Federal agencies or other agencies having jurisdiction over such matters. Also, the City shall have no liability in the event there is a reduction, impairment or termination of water service due to acts of God, accidents, strikes, boycotts, blackouts, fire, earthquakes, other casualties or other circumstances beyond the City's reasonable control.
- 11. The Customer hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Boynton Beach, Florida, its Mayor, Members of the City Commission, Officers, employees and agents (Both in their individual and official capacities) from and against all claims, damages, law suits and expenses including reasonable attorneys fees (whether or not incurred on appeal or in connection with post judgment collection) and costs rising out of or resulting from the Customer's obligation under or performance pursuant to this Agreement.
- 12. No additional agreements or representations shall be binding on any of the parties hereto unless incorporated in this Agreement. No modifications or change in this Agreement shall be valid upon the parties unless in writing executed by the parties to be bound thereby.

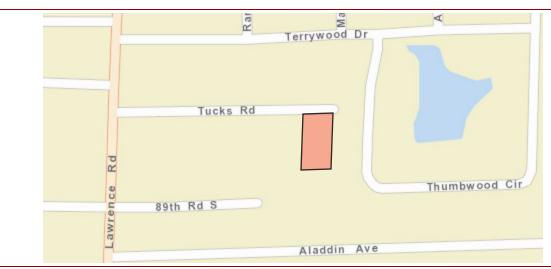

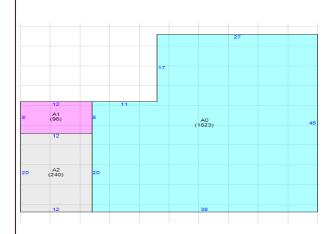

AGREEMENT FOR WATER SERVICE OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS AND COVENANT FOR ANNEXATION

THIS AGREEMENT made this 20 day of MOVID, 2002, by and between JEAN DAHLGREN, TRUSTEE U/A 10/04/89, CLARK E. DAHLGREN AND JEAN DAHLGREN hereinafter called the "Customer", CONTINENTAL HOMES OF FLORIDA, INC., a Florida corporation, hereinafter called "Contract Vendee" and the CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, hereinafter called the "CITY".

WHEREAS, Customer owns real property outside of the jurisdictional limits of the City of Boynton Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Customer has requested that the City of Boynton Beach, Florida provide water service to the property owned by Customer; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Contract Vendee to obtain zoning approval for commercial development from the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners, the property owner must be able to access water services; and

WHEREAS, the Contract Vendee only requires water service if it purchases the subject property from Customer; and

WHEREAS, all parties recognize that this agreement is valid only upon the occurrence of the Contract Vendee, Continental Homes of Florida, Inc., purchasing the property from Customer, at which time the Customer will voluntary annex into the City of Boynton Beach; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boynton Beach has the ability to provide water service to Customer's property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boynton Beach has a policy which conditions the grant of water services outside of its jurisdictional limits on annexation of the property to be serviced into the City at the earliest practicable time.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the privilege of receiving water service from the Municipal Water System and the mutual covenants expressed herein, the City of Boynton Beach, the Customer, the Contract Vendee and their respective heirs, successors and assigns, agree as follows:

- The City agrees to provide Customer with water service from its Municipal Water System to service the real property (the "Property") described as follows and which Customer represents is owned by Customer; (Exhibit A).
- 2. The Customer and the City hereby agree that there are 120.5

Equivalent Residential Connections which City shall service.

- The Customer agrees to pay all costs and fees of engineering, material, 3. labor, installation and inspection of the facilities as required by the City of Boynton Beach Code of Ordinances or Land Development regulations to provide service to the Customer's premises. The Customer shall be responsible for installation in conformance with all codes, rules and regulations applicable to the installation and maintenance of water service lines upon the Customer's premises. All such lines shall be approved by the Director of Utilities arid subject to inspection by the City Engineers. The City shall have the option of either requiring the Customer or, if the said real property has been transferred, the transferee, to perform the work necessary to conform the lines or the City may have the work performed on behalf of the Customer, in which case the Customer, or if the said real property has been transferred, the transferee, will pay in advance all estimated costs thereof. In the event the City has such work performed, the Customer, or if the said real property has been transferred, the transferee, will also advance such additional funds as may be necessary to pay the total actual costs incurred by the City.
- 4. Any water main extension made pursuant to this Agreement shall be used only by the Customer, unless written consent is granted by the City of Boynton Beach for other parties to connect. All connections shall be made in accordance with the Codes and regulations of Boynton Beach.
- 5. Title to all mains, extensions and other facilities extended from the City Water Distribution System to and including the metered service to Customer shall be vested in the City exclusively unless otherwise conveyed or abandoned to the property owner.
- 6. The Customer agrees to pay all charges, deposits and rates for service and equipment in connection with water service outside the City limits applicable under City Ordinances and rate schedules which are applicable which may be changed from time to time.
- 7. Any rights-of-way or easements necessary to accommodate the connections shall be provided by the Customer to the City.
- 8. The Customer shall, contemporaneously execute and deliver to the City an Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney granting to the City the power and authority to execute and advance on behalf of the Customer a voluntary petition for annexation. Customer covenants that it shall cooperate with the City and not raise opposition or challenge to such annexation if and when annexation is initiated. The property shall be subject to annexation at the option of the City at any time the property is eligible under any available

means or method for annexation. Customer will inform any and all assigns or purchasers of any or part of this property of this covenant and of the irrevocable special power of attorney, but Customer's failure to provide such notice shall not constitute a defense or bar to the city's rights as set forth herein. The Customer acknowledges that the consideration of initially connecting to the city's water supply is sufficient to support the grant of the power of attorney any subsequent disconnection or lack of service shall in no way impair the power of attorney nor constitute a diminution or lack of consideration.

- 9. The Customer acknowledges that this covenant regarding annexation is intended to be and is hereby made a covenant running with the land described in paragraph 1 above. This Agreement and the power of attorney referenced herein is to be recorded in the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, and the Customer and all subsequent transferees, grantees. heirs or assigns of Customer shall be binding on the Customer and all successors and assigns.
- 10. It is agreed that the City shall have no liability in the event there is a reduction, impairment or termination in water service to be provided under this Agreement due to any prohibitions, restrictions, limitations or requirements of local, regional, State or Federal agencies or other agencies having jurisdiction over such matters. Also, the City shall have no liability in the event there is a reduction, impairment or termination of water service due to acts of God, accidents, strikes, boycotts, blackouts, fire, earthquakes, other casualties or other circumstances beyond the City's reasonable control.
- 11. The Customer, or if the said real property has been transferred, the transferee, hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Boynton Beach, Florida, its Mayor, Members of the City Commission, Officers, employees and agents (both in their individual and official capacities) from and against all claims, damages, law suits and expenses including reasonable attorneys fees (whether or not incurred on appeal or in connection with post judgment collection) and costs rising out of or resulting from the Customers obligation under or performance pursuant to this Agreement.
- 12. No additional agreements or representations shall be binding on any of the parties hereto unless incorporated in this Agreement. No modifications or change in this Agreement shall be valid upon the parties unless in writing executed by the parties to be bound thereby.
- Customer hereby acknowledges that it has currently entered into a contract with Continental Homes of Florida, Inc. for the sale of Property conditioned

upon the Contract Vendee obtaining approval from the Palm Beach County Board of Commissioners and/or other municipal agencies' zoning approval for commercial development of the Property and other conditions.

This agreement shall not be effective until and unless the Customer transfers legal fee title to the Property to Continental Homes of Florida, Inc. or its successors or assigns in accordance with the terms of the contract referred to in paragraph 13 mentioned above. Upon such transfer of title, this agreement shall be in full force and effect and all obligations hereunder on the part of Customer shall be automatically transferred and assumed by the grantee named in the deed from Customer conveying title to the Property as aforesaid, whereupon Jean Dahlgren, Trustee U/A 10/04/89, Clark E. Dahlgren and Jean Dahlgren, their heirs and assigns, shall be deemed released from any further liability or obligation hereunder.

AGREEMENT FOR WATER SERVICE OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS AND COVENANT FOR ANNEXATION

THIS AGREEMENT made this / day of March, 2002, by and between WILMER FREDERICK BAUER, JR. AS TRUSTEE OF THE WILMER FREDERICK BAUER TRUST DATED THE 27TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1990, AND AS TRUSTEE OF THE ALICE SPENCER BAUER TRUST DATED THE 27TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1990, hereinafter called the "Customer", CONTINENTAL HOMES OF FLORIDA, INC., a Florida corporation, hereinafter called "Contract Vendee" and the CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, hereinafter called the "CITY".

WHEREAS, Customer owns real property outside of the jurisdictional limits of the City of Boynton Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Customer has requested that the City of Boynton Beach, Florida provide water service to the property owned by Customer; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Contract Vendee to obtain zoning approval for commercial development from the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners, the property owner must be able to access water services; and

WHEREAS, the Contract Vendee only requires water service if it purchases the subject property from Customer; and

WHEREAS, all parties recognize that this agreement is valid only upon the occurrence of the Contract Vendee, Continental Homes of Florida, Inc., purchasing the property from Customer, at which time the Customer will voluntary annex into the City of Boynton Beach; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boynton Beach has the ability to provide water service to Customer's property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boynton Beach has a policy which conditions the grant of water services outside of its jurisdictional limits on annexation of the property to be serviced into the City at the earliest practicable time.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the privilege of receiving water service from the Municipal Water System and the mutual covenants expressed herein, the City of Boynton Beach, the Customer, the Contract Vendee and their respective heirs, successors and assigns, agree as follows:

 The City agrees to provide Customer with water service from its Municipal Water System to service the real property (the "Property") described as follows and which Customer represents is owned by Customer; (Exhibit A).

- 2. The Customer and the City hereby agree that there are 120.5 Equivalent Residential Connections which City shall service.
- 3. The Customer agrees to pay all costs and fees of engineering, material, labor, installation and inspection of the facilities as required by the City of Boynton Beach Code of Ordinances or Land Development regulations to provide service to the Customer's premises. The Customer shall be responsible for installation in conformance with all codes, rules and regulations applicable to the installation and maintenance of water service lines upon the Customer's premises. All such lines shall be approved by the Director of Utilities arid subject to inspection by the City Engineers. The City shall have the option of either requiring the Customer or, if the said real property has been transferred, the transferee, to perform the work necessary to conform the lines or the City may have the work performed on behalf of the Customer, in which case the Customer, or if the said real property has been transferred, the transferee, will pay in advance all estimated costs thereof. In the event the City has such work performed, the Customer, or if the said real property has been transferred, the transferee, will also advance such additional funds as may be necessary to pay the total actual costs incurred by the City.
- 4. Any water main extension made pursuant to this Agreement shall be used only by the Customer, unless written consent is granted by the City of Boynton Beach for other parties to connect. All connections shall be made in accordance with the Codes and regulations of Boynton Beach.
- Title to all mains, extensions and other facilities extended from the City Water Distribution System to and including the metered service to Customer shall be vested in the City exclusively unless otherwise conveyed or abandoned to the property owner.
- 6. The Customer agrees to pay all charges, deposits and rates for service and equipment in connection with water service outside the City limits applicable under City Ordinances and rate schedules which are applicable which may be changed from time to time.
- Any rights-of-way or easements necessary to accommodate the connections shall be provided by the Customer to the City.
- 8. The Customer shall, contemporaneously execute and deliver to the City an Irrevocable Special Power of Attorney granting to the City the power and authority to execute and advance on behalf of the Customer a voluntary petition for annexation. Customer covenants that it shall cooperate with the

City and not raise opposition or challenge to such annexation if and when annexation is initiated. The property shall be subject to annexation at the option of the City at any time the property is eligible under any available means or method for annexation. Customer will inform any and all assigns or purchasers of any or part of this property of this covenant and of the irrevocable special power of attorney, but Customer's failure to provide such notice shall not constitute a defense or bar to the city's rights as set forth herein. The Customer acknowledges that the consideration of initially connecting to the city's water supply is sufficient to support the grant of the power of attorney any subsequent disconnection or lack of service shall in no way impair the power of attorney nor constitute a diminution or lack of consideration.

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- 9. The Customer acknowledges that this covenant regarding annexation is intended to be and is hereby made a covenant running with the land described in paragraph 1 above. This Agreement and the power of attorney referenced herein is to be recorded in the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, and the Customer and all subsequent transferees, grantees. heirs or assigns of Customer shall be binding on the Customer and all successors and assigns.
- 10. It is agreed that the City shall have no liability in the event there is a reduction, impairment or termination in water service to be provided under this Agreement due to any prohibitions, restrictions, limitations or requirements of local, regional, State or Federal agencies or other agencies having jurisdiction over such matters. Also, the City shall have no liability in the event there is a reduction, impairment or termination of water service due to acts of God, accidents, strikes, boycotts, blackouts, fire, earthquakes, other casualties or other circumstances beyond the City's reasonable control.
- 11. The Customer, or if the said real property has been transferred, the transferee, hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Boynton Beach, Florida, its Mayor, Members of the City Commission, Officers, employees and agents (both in their individual and official capacities) from and against all claims, damages, law suits and expenses including reasonable attorneys fees (whether or not incurred on appeal or in connection with post judgment collection) and costs rising out of or resulting from the Customers obligation under or performance pursuant to this Agreement.
- 12. No additional agreements or representations shall be binding on any of the parties hereto unless incorporated in this Agreement. No modifications or change in this Agreement shall be valid upon the parties unless in writing

executed by the parties to be bound thereby.

- 13. Customer hereby acknowledges that it has currently entered into a contract with Continental Homes of Florida, Inc. for the sale of Property conditioned upon the Contract Vendee obtaining approval from the Palm Beach County Board of Commissioners and/or other municipal agencies' zoning approval for commercial kdevelopment of the Property and other conditions.

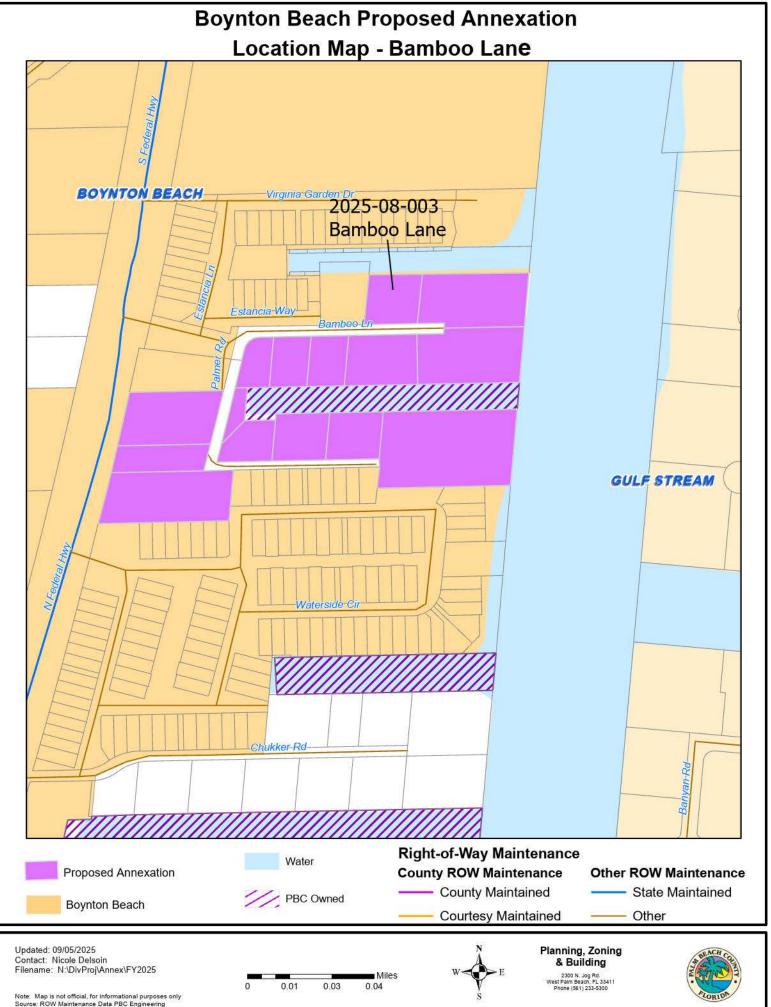

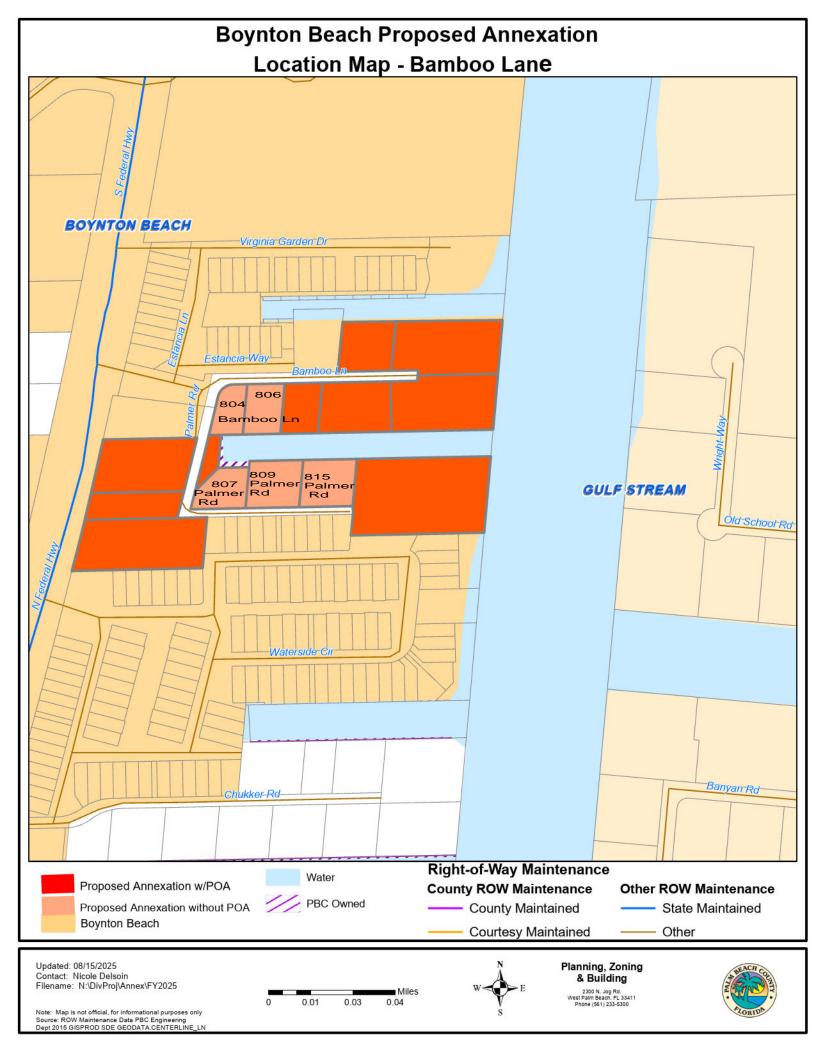
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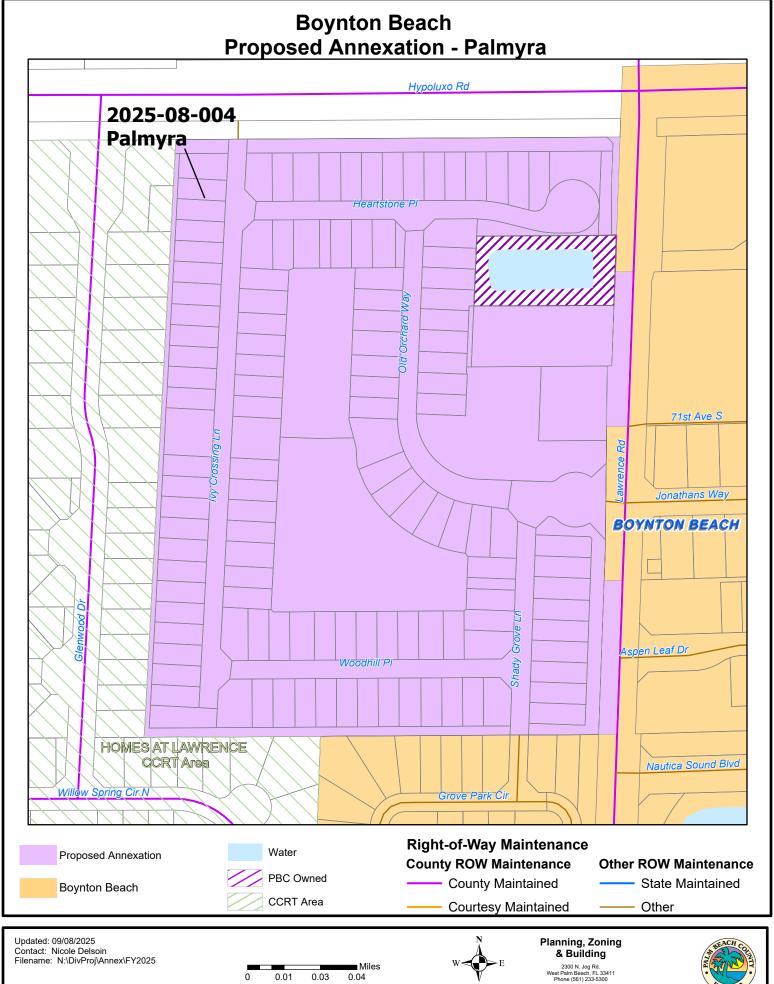
Bamboo Lane Location Maps

Annexations Update

Staff will be providing an update to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on the Palmyra and Bamboo Lane Voluntary Annexations at the September 25, 2025 Zoning Hearing.

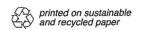
Summary: Palm Beach County has received a filing for voluntary annexation from the City of Boynton Beach (August 4, 2025). The City seeks to voluntarily annex approximately 39.37 acres of land at the southwest corner of Hypoluxo Road and Lawrence Road (Palmyra) and approximately 4.6 acres of land approximately 570 feet south of the intersection of Federal Highway and Old Dixie Highway on the east side of Federal Highway (Bamboo Lane). The City has scheduled its adoption hearing on October 7, 2025. The filing includes two petitions which include sworn statements from the City Manager, acting as the Attorney-in-Fact, for the property owners through the water service agreements. The issue is whether the consents based on the powers of attorney are proper.

Background: Florida Statutes 171.044, Voluntary Annexation allows the owner or owners of real property in an unincorporated area of a county which is contiguous to a municipality and reasonably compact to petition the County to annex into the City of Boynton Beach.

Chapter 171, Florida Statutes

Chapter 171, Florida Statutes (F.S.) governs the annexation of land, and defines 'annexation' as "the adding of real property to the boundaries of an incorporated municipality, such addition making such real property in every way a part of the municipality".

- 1. Ensure sound urban development and accommodation to growth.
- 2. Establish uniform standards throughout the state.
- 3. Ensure the efficient provision of urban services to areas that become urban in character.
- 4. Ensure that areas are not annexed unless municipal services can be provided to those areas.

Chapter 171.044, Voluntary Annexation

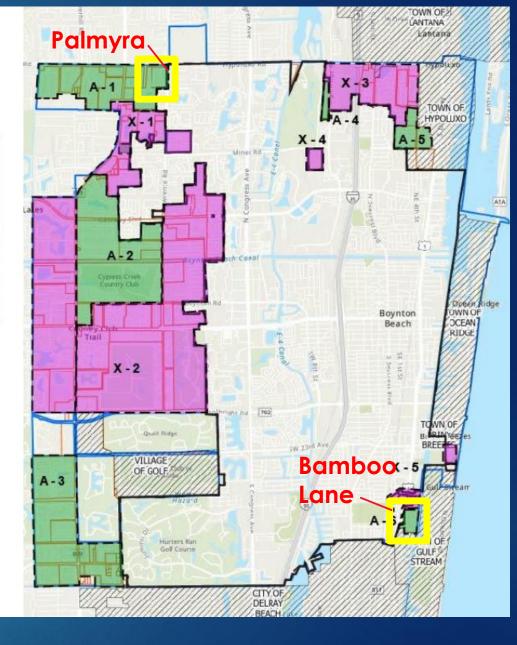
- Property owner petitions an adjacent municipality to be annexed.
- Municipality provides notification to the County.
- Municipality is required to review the ordinance at a public hearing (first reading) and then hold a separate public hearing (second reading) for adopting the ordinance.

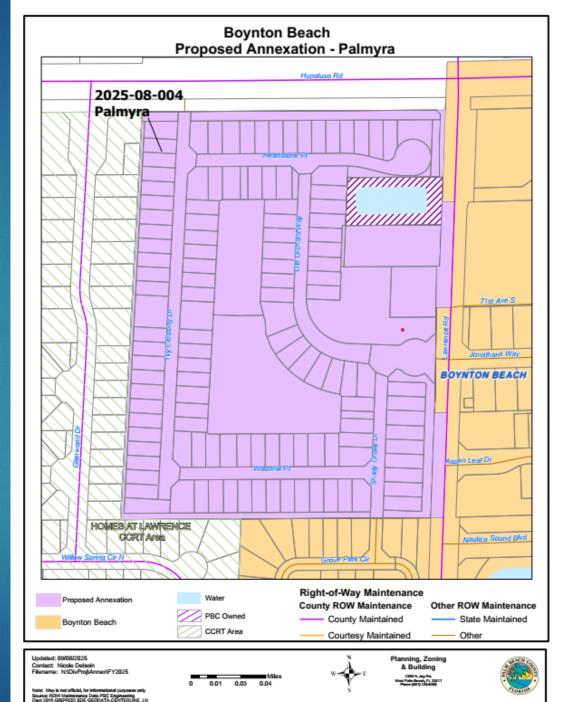




Palmyra – District 2

- The 34.67 Acre area consists of 123 residential lots located at the southwest corner of Hypoluxo and Lawrence Rd. Part of the larger 2024 Boynton Beach annexation feasibility study.
- Petition, signed by the City Manager stating that he has the Power of Attorney (POA), for annexation purposes, from all of the owners of Palmyra development through a water service agreement.

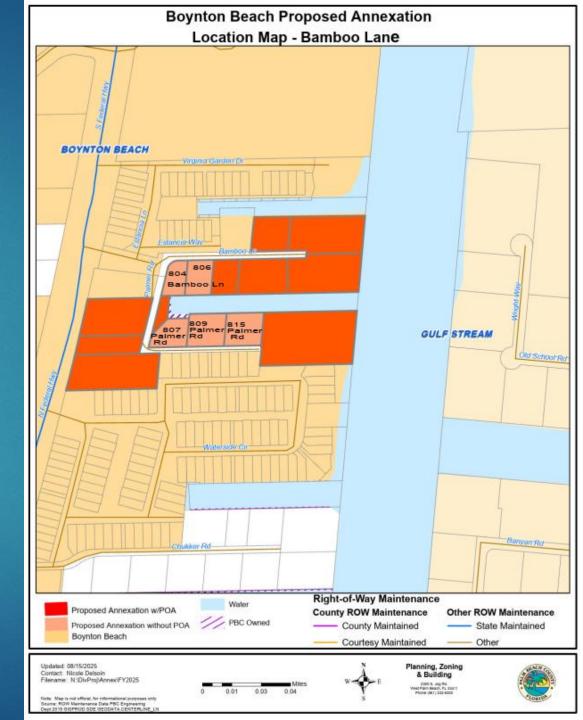




Bamboo Lane – District 4

- The 4.6 acre area proposed to be annexed is located south of the intersection of Old Dixie Hwy and S Federal Highway. Part of the larger 2024 Boynton Beach feasibility study.
- For the Five (5) highlighted parcels, Power-of-Attorney (POA) not signed by current owners. The remaining 10 parcel owners have given POA to the city through water service agreements.
