Motion and Title: **Staff recommends motion to approve:** Reappointment of one (1) member to the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB), for the term November 1, 2025, through October 31, 2028.

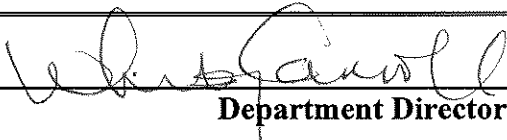
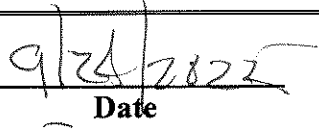
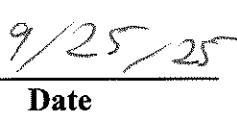

Summary: The CILB establishes qualifications and competence of contractors that work within the County. The CILB also provides for the testing and licensing of these contractors, and is empowered to discipline licensees, and hear citation appeals. The CILB was established by Special Act, Laws of Florida, Chapter 67-1876, as amended. The Special Act and, subsequently, Section 489.131, Florida Statutes sets forth the membership of the CILB, which consists of 15 members. The CILB shall be comprised of 15 members as follows: two (2) general contractors, one (1) member from each of the following contractor categories: building, residential; electrical; plumbing; HARV (Heating, Air Conditioning, Refrigeration and Ventilation), roofing; swimming pool; one (1) architect; one (1) engineer and one (1) full-time building official employed by a local government within Palm Beach County, who meets the requirements of the Building Officials Association of Florida; and three (3) consumer representatives. A memorandum was sent to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on September 8, 2025, requesting support to re-appoint one (1) current CILB member. The CILB currently has 12 out of 15 seats filled. **Countywide** (RM)

Background and Justification: The membership of the CILB consists of two (2) general contractors, and one (1) member of the following categories: building, residential, electrical, plumbing, HARV roofing, swimming pool, architect, engineer, and building official. In addition, Section 489.131, Florida Statutes requires that we have three (3) Consumer Representatives. The CILB establishes qualifications and competency of contractors that work within the County. The CILB also provides for the testing and licensing of these contractors and is empowered to discipline licenses.

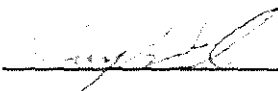

The purpose of this memo is to request your support for the re-nomination of one current and active board member to the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB). The nominee is as follows:

-Mr. Jerry Wilson, who has been an active member, has attended 25 out of 29 monthly board meetings during his 3-year term, and has indicated a willingness to continue serving for a second term in seat three as a General Contractor.

The term for this nominee would begin November 1, 2025, through October 31, 2028. The application and resume for the above-mentioned member is attached for your review and signature located on page two.

The CILB was created by Special Act 67-1876 in 1967 and is comprised of fifteen (15) members, representative of the construction industry and citizens within Palm Beach County. Although specific member representation is set forth in Special Act 67-1876 and Chapter 489 F.S. as amended, the members are appointed by the BCC.

The CILB is responsible for approving all applications for certification examinations and requests for change of status and may take disciplinary action against a county certified contractor for violation of contractor certification laws. The CILB meets monthly (except during the month of November), usually on the fourth Monday.

Please respond within the next ten (10) days identifying the current member re-appointment or your choice of a new nominee. A copy of the candidate's resume must also be provided.

Special Act, Chapter 67-1876, Laws of Florida as amended

Board Member Qualifications

Section 3. Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County, organization, meetings, powers, duties. —

- (A.) The Construction Industry Licensing Board of Palm Beach County is hereby created and composed of the following: two general contractors, one contractor who is primarily engaged in the business of furnishing those services to which a building contractor is limited, one contractor who is primarily engaged in the business of furnishing those services to which a residential contractor is limited, one electrical contractor, one plumbing contractor, one HARV contractor, one roofing contractor, one swimming pool contractor, one architect, one engineer, and one full-time building official, employed by a local government within Palm Beach County who meets the requirements of the Building Officials Association of Florida. All members of the Board shall be appointed by the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners.
- (B.) To be eligible for appointment each contractor member shall be:
- (1) Actively engaged in the construction business in Palm Beach County and have held a certificate of competency in his name and have been so engaged for a period of not less than 5 consecutive years immediately before the date of his appointment, and be a resident of Palm Beach County. The architect and engineer member shall be licensed in the State of Florida and be a resident of Palm Beach County.
 - (2) Each member of the Board except the Building Official shall hold a valid certificate issued by this Board or the state of Florida in addition to having the qualifications required in subsection (B) (1) above.
 - (3) In the event that any member of the Board no longer possesses the qualifications required in subsection (B) (1) and (B) (2) above, said member may be suspended or removed as a member of the Board upon a majority vote. If a member fails to attend three successive, regular scheduled meetings, he may be removed by a majority vote of the Board.
- (C.) All terms of office expire on September 30 of the last year of the term. As the terms of members expire, the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint a member to fill the vacancy for a term of 3 years, but no member shall serve for more than two consecutive terms but may be reappointed after a three (3) year hiatus. Vacancies in the membership of the board for any cause shall be filled by the Board of County Commissioners for the balance of the unexpired term.

Board Member Qualifications

Florida Statutes 489.131 Applicability:

- (10) No municipal or county government may issue any certificate of competency or license for any contractor defined in s. 489.105(3)(a)-(o) after July 1, 1993, unless such local government exercises disciplinary control and oversight over such locally licensed contractors, including forwarding a recommended order in each action to the board as provided in subsection (7).

Each local board that licenses and disciplines contractors must have at least two consumer representatives on that board. If the board has seven or more members, at least three of those members must be consumer representatives. The consumer representative may be any resident of the local jurisdiction who is not and has never been, a member or practitioner of a profession regulated by the board or a member of any closely related profession.
