I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: Resolution repealing and replacing Resolution 2013-0242 regarding the Division of Senior and Veterans Services (DSVS), authorizing the County Administrator, or his designee, signatory authority for individual agreements, amendments, and any other necessary documents related to the Area Agency on Aging of Palm Beach/Treasure Coast, Inc. (AAA); the Florida Department of Elder Affairs (DOEA); and the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA), that do not exceed 30% of the grant award or \$500,000, whichever is greater, effective February 3, 2026.

Summary: An amended resolution is necessary to authorize signature authority for individual agreements, amendments, Adult Day Care licensing documents, and any other required paperwork related to grants or contracts with AAA, DOEA, and AHCA. DSVS receives annual federal and state grant funds through agreements or contracts with AAA and DOEA. These contracts are periodically updated to reflect budgetary priorities and to adjust award amounts when unused federal funds become available.

Additionally, DSVS Adult Day Care programs require licensure and biennial renewal by the AHCA to ensure compliance with the rules and regulations adopted by the State of Florida, as authorized under Chapter 429, Part III, Florida Statutes, and Rule 59A-16 of the Florida Administrative Code.


Delegating signatory authority to the County Administrator, or his designee, for individual agreements, amendments, and other necessary documents within the defined threshold will allow for timely spending of funds and ensure compliance with grant mandates. All agreements, amendments, and related documents signed by the County Administrator, or his designee, will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) as receive-and-file items in accordance with PPM CW-O-051. Countywide except for portions of Districts 2, 4, 5, and 7 south of Hypoluxo Rd. (JBR)

Background and Policy Issues: DSVS receives federal Older Americans Act and DOEA funds both through the AAA and directly from the DOEA. To ensure funds are expended efficiently, delegation of signatory authority to the County Administrator, or his designee, is recommended to expedite grant agreements, amendments, and any other necessary documents.



COAST, INC. (AAA), AND FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
ELDER AFFAIRS (DOEA), AND AGENCY FOR HEALTH
CARE ADMINISTRATION (AHCA)
AGREEMENTS/CONTRACTS; REPEALING AND
REPLACING RESOLUTION R2013-0242.**

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County has been notified that the Division of Senior and Veterans Services is a Lead Agency which will receive Federal and State funds through Area Agency on Aging of Palm Beach/Treasure Coast, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, since streamlining of the agenda process has increased the length of time between Board meetings and it is imperative that any other necessary documents be executed with the greatest dispatch; and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County has adopted an optional Home Rule Charter pursuant to Section 1(g) of Article VIII of the Florida State Constitution and Chapter 125 of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Section 125.85, Florida Statutes, authorizes the delegation of any powers and duties not set forth therein by resolution or ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the delegation of signing authority to the County Administrator, or his designee, on AAA agreements/contracts for the program periods, November 1, 2025 through November 1, 2028 and any other necessary documents from the grantor AAA. This would eliminate delays caused by such items to be brought before the Board of County Commissioners and would therefore be consistent with the goal of the Board of County Commissioners to streamline the agenda process; and facilitate timely spending of grant funds which must be spent within a program year; and

WHEREAS, the agenda process is at times, not conducive to allowing documents to be executed with the greatest dispatch; and

WHEREAS, the delegation of signature authority to the County Administrator, or his designee, on amendments to AAA/DOEA/AHCA agreements/contracts and any other necessary documents from AAA/DOEA/AHCA would eliminate delays caused by such items to be brought before the Board of County Commissioners and would therefore be consistent with the goal of the grantee to expend funds in compliance with grant requirements; and

WHEREAS, the specific delegation of signatory authority is in accordance with PPM#CW-O-051 when said documents follow the format as set forth in paragraph 2 herein below, which document is incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:**

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are expressly incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. The County Administrator, or his designee, is hereby expressly authorized to execute, on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners, contract

amendments and any other necessary documents related to the AAA/DOEA/AHCA programs.

3. This delegation of signature authority is strictly limited to the parameters set forth herein above so that the execution of the aforementioned document by the County Administrator constitutes a ministerial act on his part in accordance with PPM #CW-0-051.



Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: Resolution Amending Resolution No. 2010-1942 regarding the Division of Senior Services (DOSS) authorizing the County Administrator, or his designee, signatory authority on individual amendments and any other necessary documents related to Area Agency on Aging of Palm Beach/Treasure Coast, Inc. (AAA) and Department of Elder Affairs (DOEA) grant agreements/contracts for not more than ten percent (10%) of the grant award or \$150,000, whichever is greater, effective March 12, 2013.

Summary: An amended resolution is necessary to allow signature authority on individual amendments and any other necessary documents related to AAA and DOEA grants agreements/contracts. DOSS receives Federal and State grant funds annually through agreements or contracts with AAA and DOEA. These contracts are adjusted periodically to align budgetary priorities and to adjust grant amounts when unused federal funds become available for distribution. Delegating signatory authority to the County Administrator, or his designee, on individual amendments and any other necessary documents within the defined threshold would facilitate the spending of funds in a timely manner in compliance with the grant mandates. Amendments signed by the County Administrator, or his designee, will be brought before the Board of County Commissioners as receive and file documents in accordance with PPM CW-O-051. (DOSS) Countywide (TKF)

Background and Justification: DOSS receives federal Older Americans Act and State Department of Elder Affairs funds both through the AAA and directly from DOEA. To ensure funds are expended in an efficient manner, delegation of signatory authority to the County Administrator, or his designee, is recommended to expedite grant amendments and any other necessary documents.


