I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Modification #2 to the Sub-Grant Agreement between the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO), to extend the period of performance of the FY 2023 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) from March 31, 2026 to June 30, 2026.

Summary: On June 4, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) accepted a FY 2023 SHSGP Grant Award on behalf of PBSO in the amount of \$336,000, for the contract period April 29, 2024 through September 30, 2025 (R2024-0651). On September 16, 2025, the BCC accepted Modification #1 which extended the grant period through March 31, 2026 (R2025-1267). Modification #2 will extend the period of performance through June 30, 2026, to allow additional time to complete the domestic security and regional intelligence sharing projects in support of the State's Homeland Security Strategic Plan. **There is no match requirement associated with this award.** The Assistance Listing Number (ALN) for this program is 97.067 and the contract number is R0916. Countywide (RS).

**MODIFICATION #2 TO SUBGRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND PALM BEACH COUNTY
SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

This Modification is made and entered into by and between the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management ("the Division"), and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office. ("Recipient"), to modify Contract Number **R0916**, which began on **April 29, 2024** ("the Agreement").

WHEREAS, the Division and the Recipient have entered into the Agreement, pursuant to which the Division has provided a subgrant to Recipient under the State Homeland Security Grant program of **\$336,000.00**.

WHEREAS, the Agreement will expire on March 31, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, the Division and the Recipient desire to extend the terms of the Agreement; and,

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 8 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

This Agreement shall begin upon execution by both parties and end on **June 30, 2026** unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph (17) of this Agreement. Consistent with the definition of "period of performance" contained in 2 C.F.R. § 200.1, the term "period of agreement" refers to the time during which the Sub-Recipient "may incur new obligations to carry out the work authorized under" this Agreement. In accordance with 2 C.F.R. § 200.1, the Sub-Recipient may receive reimbursement under this Agreement only for "allowable costs incurred during the period of performance." In accordance with section 215.971(1)(d), Florida Statutes, the Sub-Recipient may expend funds authorized by this Agreement "only for allowable costs resulting from obligations incurred during" the period of agreement.

2. All provisions of the Agreement being modified and any attachments thereto in conflict with this Modification shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this Modification, effective as of the date of the last execution of this Modification by both parties.
3. All provisions not in conflict with this Modification remain in full force and effect, and are to be performed at the level specified in the Agreement.
