

FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the Interlocal Agreement R2020-1677 dated November 17, 2020, (“Agreement”) is made as of March 10, 2021, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (“County”), and the Town of Lantana, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida (“Participant”).

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the County and Participant agree as follows:

1. The term of the Agreement is renewed beginning on April 6, 2026, and continuing through April 5, 2031, pursuant to the exercise of the first renewal option for five (5) years.
2. Section 19 of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 19: NON-DISCRIMINATION

The County is committed to assuring equal opportunity in the award of contracts and complies with all laws prohibiting discrimination. Pursuant to Palm Beach County Resolution R2025-0748, as may be amended, the Participant warrants and represents that throughout the term of the Agreement, including any renewals thereof, if applicable, all of its employees are treated equally during employment without regard to race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, or genetic information. Failure to meet this requirement shall be considered default of the Agreement.

3. The Agreement is hereby modified to add the following:

SECTION 24: E-VERIFY – EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

24.01 Participant warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov), and uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of the Participant’s contractors and subcontractors performing any duties and obligations under this Agreement are registered with and use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

24.02 County shall terminate this Agreement if it has a good faith belief that Participant has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.

4. Except as modified by this First Amendment, the Agreement remains unmodified and in full force and effect in accordance with the terms thereof and is hereby ratified and




