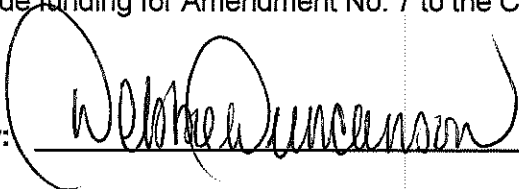

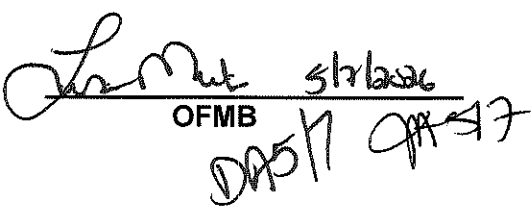

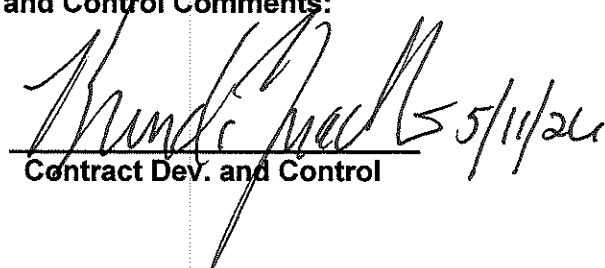

**AMENDMENT NO. 7 TO CONTRACT

This Amendment No. 7 to the Contract is made as of the 9th day of June, 2026, by and between Palm Beach County, Florida (COUNTY) and AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC., a corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the CONSULTANT, whose Federal Tax I.D. number is 95-2661922.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2023, the COUNTY entered into an Agreement (R2023-0980) with the CONSULTANT for the CONSULTANT to provide General Airport Consulting Services for the Palm Beach County Department of Airports, for a period of two (2) years, with three (3) one (1)-year renewal options, the exercise of which are within COUNTY'S sole control and discretion; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2023, the COUNTY entered into an Amendment No. 1 (R2023-1654) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach COUNTY, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2024, the COUNTY entered into an Amendment No. 2 (R2024-0110) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2024, the COUNTY entered into an Amendment No. 3 (R2024-0822) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2025, the COUNTY entered into an Amendment No. 4 (R2025-0067) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2025, the COUNTY entered into an Amendment No. 5 (R2025-0067) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services and to exercise the first one (1) year renewal option for the continuation of services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2025, the COUNTY entered into an Amendment No. 6 (R2025-1284) with the CONSULTANT to provide additional professional services for the Department of Airports, Palm Beach County, in accordance with Article 26 of the original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Article 26 of the Contract requires an amendment when the parties are able to define additional services and the parties have now defined those services;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, and such other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which the parties hereby acknowledge, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The parties hereby agree to amend the Contract to include the Scope of Services and Fees as outlined in Exhibit A. The total amount to be paid by the COUNTY to the CONSULTANT for professional services, including any out of pocket expenses, shall not exceed Nine Hundred and Eight Thousand Four Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$908,400.00) for the services in Amendment No. 7 to the original Contract.
2. The parties agree to amend the Contract to include the second one (1) year renewal option for the continuation of services, for the period from July 11, 2026 to July 11, 2027, provided by the CONSULTANT under this Contract.
3. Except as specifically amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida has made and executed this CONTRACT on behalf of the COUNTY; and an authorized official of the CONSULTANT has made and executed this CONTRACT on behalf of the CONSULTANT.
