I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$923,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO).

Summary: Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes; provides that the seizing agency shall use Forfeiture proceeds for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education and prevention programs, or for other law enforcement purposes, which include defraying the cost of protracted or complex investigations, providing additional equipment or expertise, purchasing automated external defibrillators, and providing matching grant funds. Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, also requires that no less than 25% of the LETF's previous year's revenues be used for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and school resource officer programs of various non-profit organizations. PBSO's FY2026 donation requirement is \$821,438. PBSO's support of these programs exemplifies its strong commitment to the prevention and reduction of crime throughout the communities it serves and its desire to put money back into these communities to support organizations that provide such services. The year-to-date transfer for all donations to outside organizations after approval of this item is \$3,331,250. The funds requested are to aid PBSO and qualified organizations that meet the requirements set forth in Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes. Use of LETF requires approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC), upon request of the PBSO. The current State LETF balance is \$3,705,973. Approval of this request will reduce the State LETF balance to \$2,782,973. PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes. Below is a table indicating the organizations the PBSO seeks to fund and the corresponding amount of funding proposed per respective organization or agency. No new positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. Countywide (RS) (Continued on Page 3)

Background and Justification: PBSO is dedicated to providing the most efficient and effective law enforcement services and also has a long-standing commitment to the reduction of crime and implementation of crime and drug prevention programs within Palm Beach County. Use of LETF requires approval by the BCC, in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, upon request of the PBSO. This Statute also requires that no less than 25% of the last fiscal year's revenues be donated or expended for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood or school resource officer programs. PBSO certifies that the use of these funds by the organizations listed above is in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes.

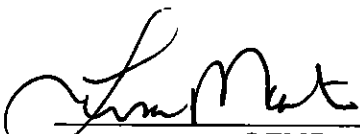

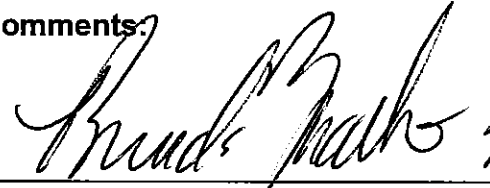

Organization Purpose:

211 provides the only 24/7 crisis hot line and community helpline in Palm Beach County on a completely free and confidential basis. Our team saves and enriches lives everyday by providing crisis intervention, suicide prevention, and connection to health, mental health and wellness resources.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

The 211 HelpLine provides critical services to Palm Beach County residents, available day or night to anyone in need regardless of their background. Residents can easily request help by calling 2-1-1, texting 898-211, emailing help@211pbtc.org, or through online chat. Our Resource Center Specialists are trained to provide evidence-based crisis intervention, emotional support, and suicide prevention services. During our last fiscal year, the 211 HelpLine served over 118,000 in our whole service region, including over 46,000 Palm Beach County residents, helping them face challenges related to substance use disorders, mental health challenges, basic needs, and housing-related crisis situations. This year, we are requesting \$75,000 from the PBSO LETF, to be allocated to a portion of the salary and benefits of 1 FTE Resource Center Specialist and 1 FTE RC Supervisor.

What results are you committed to achieving?

Our agency remains committed to providing 24/7 life saving crisis intervention and suicide prevention services to Palm Beach County residents experiencing suicidal thoughts or mental health crisis, with the goal of increasing timely access to support and reducing the escalation of emergency situations. We are also committed to properly reporting abuse, criminal activity, and life-threatening situations to the appropriate authorities, ensuring timely intervention and coordination with law enforcement. We aim to reduce non-emergency calls to 911 by connecting individuals to the appropriate resources, improving their ability to access mental health and crisis stabilization resources. We will continue to partner with PBSO on specialized safety trainings to strengthen our team's ability to recognize warning signs, respond to high-risk situations, and reduce violence.

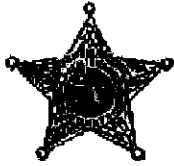

Alzheimer's Community Care is dedicated to promoting and providing community-based, family-centered care for patients and their caregivers living with neurocognitive disorders through the belief that where there is help, there is hope.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

Since its establishment in 1996, Alzheimer's Community Care has responded to calls for help from families in our community as they cope with the daily challenges of caring for their loved ones with Alzheimer's disease. Of primary importance has always been preserving the safety for both patients and caregivers throughout the disease progression. The introduction and distribution of ID Locator radio frequency and Bluetooth technology is intended to reduce resistance to lifesaving supports, lessen the exposure to injury, reduce the risk of loss of life, and allow the patient to maintain a measure of independence for as long as possible. Furthermore, caregivers will benefit from greater peace of mind knowing that their loved ones are protected.

What results are you committed to achieving?

ID Locator staff will meet with families, conduct an evaluation, and equip at-risk Alzheimer's patients with radio frequency or Bluetooth enabled locator devices. The team will provide ongoing education, support, and monthly monitoring of equipment for families. Alzheimer's Community Care will provide dementia-specific training for PBSO's Crisis Intervention team (CIT). Alzheimer's Community Care will also work in partnership with 211-Palm Beach/Treasure Coast to maintain a 24-hour assistance line.

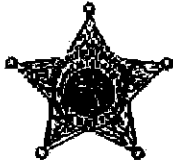

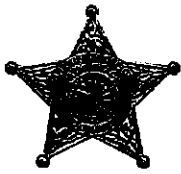

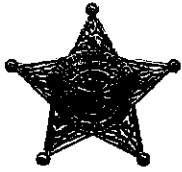

BAM! Festival is a celebration of authors and illustrators who write for children and young adults. At the event children meet their heroes, mentors, and role models rather than just read about them and their characters. BAM! Festival is a free public event for everyone in the community and held in downtown West Palm Beach. Leading up to the Saturday event authors may visit various local schools to meet students and discuss their books. A select author visits and speaks with incarcerated teenagers. Funding procured will offset the author's speaking fee and books for the teenagers at the incarcerated facilities.

What results are you committed to achieving?

For many youth, a love of reading begins with a teacher, librarian, parent, mentor or friend sharing the right book at the right time. BAM! Festival takes this simple, impactful act one step further by introducing children and teens to authors and illustrators with the hopes that these experiences will grow their confidence, inspire their imaginations, and help them see the possibilities in their own lives. Unfortunately for many students, learning to read is a challenging task made more difficult by a lack of access to books. Book deserts are a reality for children living in poverty. Verified by statistics, incarcerated youth have led lives plagued by low test scores and high dropout realities. Our vision is that one author will inspire a troubled youth with the courage to change his or her life. In 2024 BAM! Festival provided \$995 worth of books to incarcerated youth.

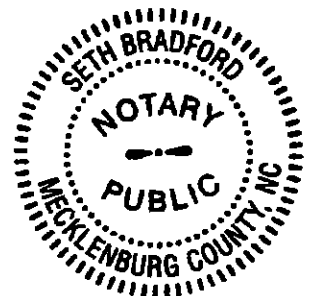

Ink cartridges for the copier and in-house printers; brochure holders; crayons and coloring books for educational purposes; paper, pens, and other items that would be needed when preparing for special events.

Funds allocated will cover staff travel expenses associated with delivering educational programming at venues throughout the community. Staff meet with families and attend events across PBC, where they distribute educational materials and provide direct support. This includes travel to/from Thea's Night Out, a community program serving children up to age 11 and supported by organizational leadership and dedicated volunteers. Reimbursement for mileage is calculated by the IRS rate of .725.

Meetings (attendees, purpose, items needed for meeting):

We host a once-a-month "Parents Night Out" program in three different locations including Palm Beach Gardens, Wellington, and Boca Raton. This program began in February 2023 with one location. In 2025, we hosted 272 children, coming from 117 families, with 266 volunteers. We will continue to use the funds from this line-item to train our volunteers (high-schoolers and adults), parents and attendees about the importance of drug prevention and safety. We implement background checks on adults.

Miscellaneous Expense (specify items):

This grant will help underwrite the "Access For All" Abilities Showcase on August 29th. This one day event will be a free event in which there will be 40+ non-profit, for-profit, and gov't agencies in which PBC residents who have loved ones (children and adults) with disabilities to learn about resources available for their family member. There will be speakers, etc. to help educate the community on many different topics.

We provide mentorship to these children and aim to make them feel like they have a family here. We want to give rest and relaxation to our military widows and provide a space for them to get to know one another and express their grief.

We also realize that this population is especially vulnerable to falling into substance abuse, crime and risky behavior due to trauma and somewhat unstable home lives. We believe that the time they spend at Operation 300 over the yers will help them stay the course, resist trouble and overcome the obstacles they've been forced to face at such a young age.
