I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Order 2024050-76 in the amount of \$1,623,000 to mill and resurface CR 880 from Duda Road to Mile Marker 6 (Improvements) utilizing Palm Beach County's (County) annual asphalt milling and resurfacing contract R2024-0748 (Contract) with Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. (Ranger).

Summary: Per County PPM CW-F-050, this Work Order exceeds the \$300,000 threshold for staff approvals of work orders to annual contracts, thus requiring approval from the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). Approval of this Work Order will allow the contractual services necessary to construct the Improvements. The Contract is one (1) of three (3) Contracts with an available cumulative total of \$70,000,000 for the annual asphalt milling and resurfacing program. Prior to this meeting date, approximately \$19,000,000 of the \$70,000,000 Contract that was approved on July 2, 2024, has been spent or encumbered. The Contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee (GSC) on December 16, 2023 and the GSC established the following Affirmative Procurement Initiative (API): a 10% minimum mandatory Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation. Ranger committed to 10% SBE participation for the life of the Contract. For this Work Order, the proposed SBE participation is 10.15%. To date, the overall SBE participation achieved on the Contract is 6.60%. The budget for the Improvements includes striping and marking costs of \$77,000 bringing the total fiscal impact to \$1,700,000. District 6 (YBH)

Background and Justification: The County intends to construct the Improvements in accordance with Work Order 2027050-76.

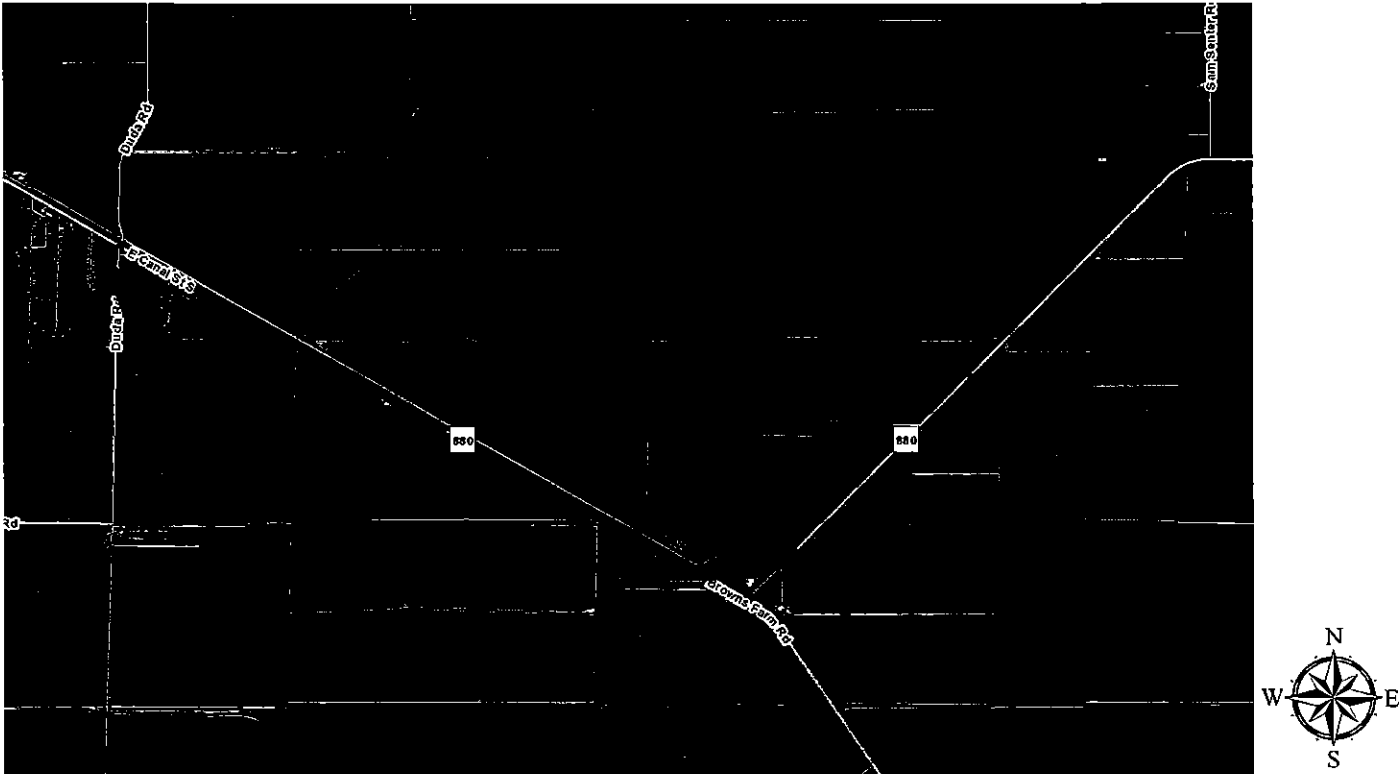

This Work Order to the Contract for Annual Milling and Resurfacing (R2024-0748), dated July 2, 2024 (**ANNUAL CONTRACT**) is made and entered into the 1st day of September, 2026, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (**COUNTY**) and RANGER CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRIES, INC. WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** and **CONTRACTOR** entered into an **ANNUAL CONTRACT** on a work order basis on July 2, 2024 (R2024-0748) as amended on November 13, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** desires the **CONTRACTOR** to mill and resurface CR-880 from Duda Road to Mile Marker 6 in Palm Beach County, Florida (**IMPROVEMENTS**); and

WHEREAS, the **CONTRACTOR** agrees to construct the **IMPROVEMENTS** in accordance with the terms and conditions of the **ANNUAL CONTRACT**, as amended, and as directed and accepted by the Engineering Department, Road & Bridge Division; and

WHEREAS, based on the pricing agreed to in the **ANNUAL CONTRACT**, the Parties agree that a cost not to exceed \$1,623,000 is appropriate compensation for the services to be performed by the **CONTRACTOR** to construct the **IMPROVEMENTS**.

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the mutual benefits that flow from each to the other, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and are incorporated herein.
2. The **CONTRACTOR** agrees to construct the **IMPROVEMENTS** in accordance with the **ANNUAL CONTRACT**, as amended, and as further described in **Exhibit "A"**.
3. The **COUNTY** agrees to pay the **CONTRACTOR** a fee not to exceed \$1,623,000 to construct the **IMPROVEMENTS**. Final payment shall be per documented quantities installed.

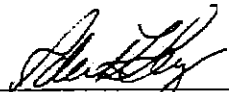

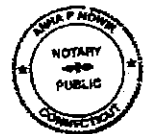

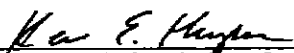
