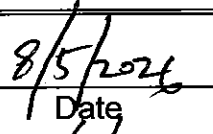
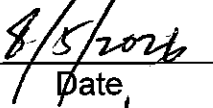
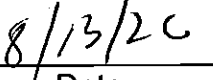
Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:

- (A) **accept** a Notice of Grant Award for the purchase of Fire Rescue Water Vessels for Hazard Mitigation (Water Vessels) (HF 1503) (SF 1051) from the Florida Department of Financial Services (FDFS) in the amount of up to \$200,000 for a period from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027;
- (B) **delegate authority** to the County Administrator, or designee, to accept, approve, execute and submit, electronically or otherwise, on County's behalf the Grant Award, contract, representations, certifications, acknowledgments, assurances, standard forms and documents, reimbursement requests, amendments, time frame changes, and other necessary documents, that do not substantially change the general scope of terms and conditions of the Grant; and
- (C) **approve** a Budget Amendment of \$200,000 within the Fire/Rescue Municipal Service Taxing Unit Fund to recognize the Grant Award from the FDFS.

Summary: In 2026, the County submitted a Florida Senate – Local Funding Initiative Request for Water Vessels. The \$200,000 funding request was sponsored by Senator Lori Berman and the FDFS (CSFA 43.010) Notice of Grant Award was received on July 1, 2026. The Grant Award provides up to \$200,000 of funding from FDFS for the purchase of a boat and trailer for Lake Okeechobee and an airboat, trailer, and tow vehicle for the Arthur Marshall Wildlife Reserve. The equipment will increase the readiness to respond to water related incidents. The equipment must be purchased within the defined performance period of one (1) year. The Grant Award **requires a 50% match (\$200,000)** which will be funded through Fire Rescue Contingency Reserves. **Countywide (SB)**

Background and Justification: This Grant Award is being awarded by the FDFS. These funds were not requested through a formal Grant request. During Palm Beach County Day, Fire Rescue shared with legislators the need for Fire Recue Water Vessels to increase readiness to respond to water related incidents. Laws of Florida Chapter 2026-232 appropriation 2544A is a State budget appropriation that is used for local projects and community initiatives. The Division of State Fire Marshal within FDFS notified Fire Rescue of the Grant Award on July 1, 2026.
