I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$885,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETf) to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO).

Summary: Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes; provides that the seizing agency shall use Forfeiture proceeds for school resource officer, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, drug abuse education and prevention programs, or for other law enforcement purposes, which include defraying the cost of protracted or complex investigations, providing additional equipment or expertise, purchasing automated external defibrillators, and providing matching grant funds. Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, also requires that no less than 25% of the LETf's previous year's revenues be used for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and school resource officer programs of various non-profit organizations. PBSO's FY2026 donation requirement is \$821,438. PBSO's support of these programs exemplifies its strong commitment to the prevention and reduction of crime throughout the communities it serves and its desire to put money back into these communities to support organizations that provide such services. The year-to-date transfer for all donations to outside organizations after approval of this item is \$4,215,250. The funds requested are to aid PBSO and qualified organizations that meet the requirements set forth in Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes. Use of LETf requires approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC), upon request of the PBSO. The current State LETf balance is \$2,782,973. Approval of this request will reduce the State LETf balance to \$1,897,973. PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes. Below is a table indicating the organizations the PBSO seeks to fund and the corresponding amount of funding proposed per respective organization or agency. No new positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. Countywide (RS) (Continued on Page 3)

Background and Justification: PBSO is dedicated to providing the most efficient and effective law enforcement services and also has a long-standing commitment to the reduction of crime and implementation of crime and drug prevention programs within Palm Beach County. Use of LETf requires approval by the BCC, in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, upon request of the PBSO. This Statute also requires that no less than 25% of the last fiscal year's revenues be donated or expended for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood or school resource officer programs. PBSO certifies that the use of these funds by the organizations listed above is in accordance with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes.

Organization Purpose:

Center for Family Services of Palm Beach County, Inc. (CFS) is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to strengthen individuals and families through behavioral health services and education.

Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

CFS's Partners for Change – Recovery Program (PFC) is a multi-level outpatient substance use treatment program providing comprehensive assessments, individualized treatment planning, weekly individual and group therapy, family counseling, case management, relapse prevention training, and recovery support services. Services are delivered in person and via telehealth in English, Spanish, Creole, and Portuguese. PFC provides trauma-informed care aligned with ASAM and SAMHSA criteria. CFS is one of two treatment providers for the County's adult drug court program & the juvenile drug court program. These programs reduce recidivism, crime rates, and improve overall community wellness. CFS is also an active participant in PBSO's threat management team, providing therapeutic services to identified high risk community members.

What results are you committed to achieving?

PFC is committed to helping clients reduce or abstain from substance misuse, decrease relapse risk, and improve overall mental health and daily functioning. Clients will develop coping skills, identify early warning signs, understand the impact of substance misuse, and create personalized recovery plans. The program aims to reduce recidivism, particularly among court-involved participants, strengthen family relationships, and improve long-term stability. With individualized treatment, case management, and ongoing recovery support, clients achieve measurable progress toward sustained recovery and their long-term life goals.

We are requesting a portion of an individual salary for a full-time therapist providing services in this program.

The individual employee is V.L. The employee holds a master's degree and is a registered intern with the state of Florida. Their base salary is \$53,500 per year, with an annual salary supplement of \$1,500 for providing services in an additional language (Spanish), for a total of \$55,000 per year.

No professional fees are requested for this project. CFS works with Legal Aid Society of PBC for legal advice and Holyfield & Thomas for accounting/audit. We would be happy to provide PBSO with additional details if necessary.

The program focuses on breaking the cycle of poverty and crime by addressing one of their root causes: low literacy. Partnering with Pioneer Park and Pahokee elementary schools, JustWorld funds StoryBook Treasures literacy program, a research-based initiative that builds reading skills, confidence and a love of reading in pre-K through third grade students. Through teacher training, classroom instruction, and take-home books and treasures, the program reinforces learning and a personal library as a foundation for long-term success. The program's crime prevention focus lies in its early intervention model, to reduce the risk factors associated with school dropout, the program sets them on a path toward opportunity and stability, rather than cycles of poverty and violence.

The Pace Palm Beach Reach Program (Pace Reach) was established in 2017 as a community-based counseling program for girls. An emphasis is on prevention efforts to bolster girls' protective factors and increase the likelihood that girls will achieve success in school, engage in healthy interpersonal relationships, have greater self-determination, and become advocates for equitable social norms and opportunities.

What results are you committed to achieving?

The Pace Reach Program is a prevention and early intervention program targeting girls at-risk of entering the juvenile justice system which helps support community safety and justice. Pace Reach applies the risk-need-responsivity approach during the assessment process with all girls/families, valuing the importance of appropriate intervention matching based on the risk and protective factors identified. Pace Reach provides services to at-risk girls in the community to reduce rates of girls' arrests. In fiscal year 2025, our goal is for girls who complete Pace Reach to have zero involvement in the juvenile justice system one year after completion and demonstrate improvement in risk factors associated with behavioral risks that precipitate delinquency as evidenced by POSIT scores.



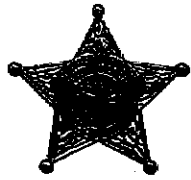

Sweet Dream Makers promotes and improves the health and well-being of children and families by providing beds, bedding, and essential furniture at no cost. Most recipient families are the working poor or transitioning from homelessness. More than 24,000 beds have been provided since 2016.

Sweet Dream Makers ensures that each child receives:

- A new mattress and box spring or memory foam mattress
- A mattress encasement to protect against bed bugs and bed-wetting (a frequent occurrence among children suffering the effects of trauma)

Vita Nova's new Street Outreach Program bolsters neighborhood safety by engaging homeless youth ages 18 to 25 and guiding them toward self-sufficiency.
