#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** a Contract with The Crom Corporation for construction of the Water Treatment Plants No. 3, No. 8 and Lake Region water storage tanks in the amount of \$5,575,000.

**Summary:** On June 13, 2006, one (1) bid was received for construction of the Water Treatment Plant (WTP) No. 3, No. 8 and Lake Region water storage tanks with The Crom Corporation being the low bidder in the amount of \$5,575,000. This Contract provides for construction of a five million gallon water storage tank at WTP No. 3 and WTP No. 8, a three million gallon water storage tank at the Lake Region Water Treat Plant, and construction of baffle walls inside the existing water storage tanks at WTP No. 2. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15.00% overall. This Contract with The Crom Corporation provides for SBE participation of 17.53% overall.

Background and Justification: The expansion of WTP No. 3 was completed in 2006 while WTP No. 8 and LRWTP are currently under construction. The water storage tanks were bid as a separate contract from the water treatment plant construction contracts to save costs typically associated with general contractor markup. This Contract provides for construction of a five million gallon water storage tanks at WTP No. 3 and No. 8, a three million gallon water storage tank at the LRWTP and construction of baffle walls inside the existing water storage tanks at WTP No. 2 to improve chlorine contact time. On June 13, 2006, one (1) bid was received for the construction of the water treatment plant No. 3, No. 8 and Lake Region Water Storage Tanks with The Crom Corporation being the low bidder in the amount of \$5,575,000. The bid amount is below the pre-bid estimate of our Consulting Engineer, Camp Dresser & McKee, Inc. Staff has reviewed the bid and recommends award to The Crom Corporation.
