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## What is Citizens Animal Patrol?

*Animal Care and Control (ACC) is offering an opportunity for interested and qualified residents to help educate the public on the need to spay or neuter their dogs and cats, animal abuse and other animal welfare issues.*

*Each year, Animal Care and Control impounds over 28,000 dogs, cats, livestock and exotic animals. Many of these animals are unwanted, strays, sick or injured. Too many animals are being needlessly given up and euthanized. Services are available for people in need. Education is the key and you can make a difference.*

*If you can drive your own vehicle and can offer a minimum of four (4) hours per week, complete the application and return to Animal Care and Control, Citizens Animal Patrol, 7100 Belvedere Road, West Palm Beach, Florida 33411. Call 233-1260 or 1280 for more information.*

*Responsibilities involve staffing a booth at pet supply stores and special events in the county, patrolling known problem areas for non-compliant issues and report findings to ACC. The development of open line communication between the public and ACC is very important and a key function for Citizens Animal Patrol.*

*Selected persons should be prepared to be involved with the Animal Disaster Response Team (DRT) and the Disaster Pet Friendly Shelter (disaster shelter for both pets and people).*

*An interview will be scheduled. A training workshop is required with a \$25 material fee. There are 10-12 hours of classroom training and 40 hours of field training.*
