Thank you for your interest in volunteering for Palm Beach County Animal Care and Control. If you are a student between 12 and 16 years of age, you may wish to participate in this program. You will receive community service hours for school or court appointed credit.

In order to receive credit, you must bring the completed application with you when dropping off the collected supplies. The student must complete an application each time supplies are dropped off or you will not receive credit. Either the parent or guardian **MUST** sign the application for approval.

The total number of credit hours will be documented each time there is a drop off on the completed application. You will receive a copy.

By being a participant of the Student Collection Program, you are helping the shelter animals. The supplies you collect are used to support the shelter's Foster Care Program.

You may wish to become a Foster Care Volunteer and earn hours. This program involves taking care of young kittens or puppies temporarily at your home. Once old enough, they are returned to the shelter for adoption.
