Urban Redevelopment update on Comprehensive Plan and ULDC Amendments in 2011 Rounds.

D. Zoning Director

Zoning Director advised the BCC that the Zoning Division has received a request from Industry for amendments to Article 4, Renewable Energy-Wind in the 2011-01 Round. The amendments previously adopted in 2009 were not comprehensive because industry had informed staff wind energy was not a viable renewable energy in PBC. However, an applicant has a viable project they would like to submit to the County for review and would like to work with staff to amend the code to reflect the most current national standards for renewable energy for wind.

The BCC gave staff direction to move forward with the amendment in the 2011-01 Round of ULDC Amendments.
