

B. C. C. RESOLUTION NO. R-71-109  
MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED April 15, 1971

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 15th day of April, 1971, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

the West 352 feet of that portion of Tract 17, Block 4, lying Easterly of Florida's Turnpike, less the Northerly 226.94 feet, as measured along the East line of said Tract 17, also less the East 100 feet and the South 33 feet of said Tract 17, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Sections 28 and 33, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 46 containing 1 1/2 acres, more or less, is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to M-1 Industrial District.
