

B. C. C. RESOLUTION NO. R-71-110  
MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED APRIL 15, 1971

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 15th day of April, 1971, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

the East 1/2 of Tract 41, Block 6, less the West 132 feet and canal right-of-way thereof, and a parcel of land, containing approximately 4 acres, in Tract 40, Block 6, located in the Northwest corner of the intersection of Southern Boulevard and Pike Road, with an East line of 622.19 feet, North line of 424.92 feet, West line of 518.98 feet and a South line of 103.25 feet, all in Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Section 33, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 46 is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to C-1A Limited Commercial District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Culpepper, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as
