

B. C. C. RESOLUTION NO. 157
MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED MAY 27, 1971

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 27th day of May, 1971, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

Under Section 14-2(b) - 1 State Highways, add subparagraph (b) as follows:

State Road 809 (Military Trail) building setback lines shall be a minimum of ninety (90) feet from the centerline of the required one hundred twenty (120) foot right-of-way from Schall Road to P. G. A. Boulevard and further, from P. G. A. Boulevard north any extension thereof to allow for a marginal access road.

Offstreet parking spaces on said access road may be included in the offstreet parking requirements when approved by the Palm Beach County Engineering Department.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Culpepper, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weaver, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
