

B. C. C. ZONING RESOLUTION NO. 158
MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED MAY 27, 1971

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 27th day of May, 1971, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

All of Tracts 78 through 83, 110 and 111, and a 30 foot right-of-way adjoining Tracts 81 through 83, less the rights-of-way of Florida's Turnpike and Lake Worth Drainage District, also less the North 134 feet of the West 156 feet of the remaining portion of Tract 80, all being in Block 23, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Sections 20, 21, 28, and 29, Township 44 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 47 is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to R-2 Multiple Family Dwelling District

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Culpepper, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
