

RESOLUTION No. R-71-226

REQUESTING THAT THE ZONING COMMISSION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPT AND ENFORCE A BUILDING SETBACK OF ONE HUNDRED (100) FEET ON EACH SIDE OF THE CENTERLINE, AS LAID OUT AND IN USE, FOR SR-808, BOCA RATON WEST ROAD (GLADES ROAD), FROM THE EAST END OF THE LIMITED ACCESS RIGHT OF WAY FOR I-95 TO SR-7 AND, FURTHER, FROM SR-7 WEST ANY EXTENSION THEREOF

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of public safety that a minimum building setback be established on each side of the centerline of SR-808, Boca Raton West Road (Glades Road, from the east end of the limited access right of way for I-95 to SR-7 and any extension westward thereof by virtue of the vehicular traffic demands on and projected for this arterial highway facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled on this 13th day of July, A.D. 1971, that the Zoning Commission of Palm Beach County, Florida, be requested to adopt and enforce the building setback of one hundred (100) feet on each side of the centerline, as laid out and in use, or any westward extension thereof for the following arterial State highway:

STATE ROAD 808 - Boca Raton West Road (Glades Road) from the east end of the limited access right of way for I-95 to SR-7 and, further, from SR-7 west any extension thereof.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weaver and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
