

B. C. C. ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-71-237
MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED JULY 15, 1971

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 15th day of July, 1971, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

Lots 15, 42, 43, 70, 71, 97, and 98, Block 81, Palm Beach Farms Company subdivision, Plat No. 3 in Section 30, Township 47 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 53 and bounded as follows: on the North by the North line of said Lot 15; on the East by the West right-of-way line of Southwest 66th Avenue as shown on the plat of Sandalfoot Cove Section Two, recorded in Plat Book 29, Pages 15 and 16, and the Northerly extension thereof; on the West by a line 84 feet East of and parallel to the centerline of the pavement of State Road No. 7 (the same as now located and existing); and on the South by a line that is 821.21 feet North of (as measured at right angles) and parallel to the North right-of-way line of Southwest 14th Street as shown on the plat of Sandalfoot Cove Section One, recorded in Plat Book 28, Pages 225 and 226 is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to R-2 Multiple Family Dwelling District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Culpepper, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
