ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-72-94

MODIFYING PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT
REGARDING STRUCTURES

ADOPTED February 17, 1972

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA,
in regular session assembled this the 17th day of February, 1972,
adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57, pursuant
to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691,
Special Laws of Florida 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of
Florida 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

Modify, SECTION 14-26 PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT
CONDITIONAL USES AND REQUIREMENTS, paragraph 1
to read as follows:

The tract of land proposed shall have a minimum area
of 100 acres for a Unit Development Plan which contains
single-family, two-family, multi-family and/or hotel
and motel structures, individually or collectively, and
commercial uses; or a minimum of 20 acres for a Unit
Development Plan which contains no commercial uses.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner

Warren, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded
by Commissioner Lytal, and upon being put to a vote, the
vote was as follows:
