ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-72-337

MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED June 15, 1972

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 15th day of June 1972, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57, pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

The South 1/2 of the following described property:  
The West 1/2 of Tracts 56, 65 and 76 except that portion of Tract 76 which lies South of the West Palm Beach Canal, less the right-of-way for State Road 80 and said canal, in Section 34, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 46; is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to C-2 General Commercial District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lytal, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

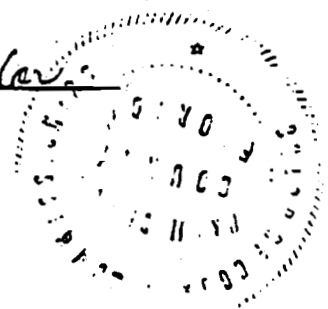
