

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-21 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 April 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of April, 1973, that petition No. 73-21, the petition of ROBERT W. BELL for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW EXCAVATION AND REMOVAL OF EXTRACTIVE MATERIALS on Block 40 and 41, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Sections 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, Township 45 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 49. Said property located on the east side of Florida's Turnpike and the north side of L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 20 in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special condition:

- (1) Excavation and removal of extractive materials and rehabilitation of the property to be completed in two (2) years (April, 1975.)
