

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-22 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 April 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of April, 1973, that petition No. 73-22, the petition of ARCHBISHOP COLEMAN F. CARROLL by the Reverend Charles Sullivan for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A CHURCH AND APPURTENANT FACILITIES on Lot 4, Replat of Marshall Morton Estates in Section 10, Township 42 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 24, page 1. Said property located on the east side of S. R. No. 703 approximately 1/4 mile south of Village Road in an RS-Residential Single Family District, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special conditions:

- (1) Provide for the reservation of a one hundred eight (108) foot right-of-way for State Road 703;
- (2) Submission and approval of a revised site plan.
