

RESOLUTION NO. R-74- 346

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-65 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 April 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of April, 1974, that petition No. 74-65, the petition of OLD DIXIE FIRE CONTROL TAX DISTRICT NO. 2 by J.J. Burkette, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A FIRE STATION on Lot A-9, Plat of Palm Beach Cabana Colony Commercial Area, in Section 31, Township 41 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 27, page 59. Said property located on the east side of S.R. No. A-1-A approximately 850 feet north of Atlantic Road in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised.


The Chairman thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this 7th day of May, 1974, confirming action of 25 April 1974.
