RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, ~~as the governing~~ body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

Said property located approximately .1 mile south of Forest Hill Boulevard on the east side of Alice Avenue in an RH-Residential Multiple Family District (High Density), was approved as advertised.
