

RESOLUTION NO. R-78- 688

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 78-74 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 30 May 1978.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 30th day of May, 1978, that petition No. 78-74 the petition of ROBERT L. POPE, SR. for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, IN PART, AND RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT, IN PART TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of Lots 12 and 13, less the West 80 feet and Lots 14 and 15, less the South 15 feet of said Lots 13, 14 and 15, Lakewood Gardens, Plat No. 3, in Section 19, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 22, page 14. Said property located on the northwest corner of the intersection of 10th Avenue North and Gulfstream Road, was denied as advertised.

Commissioner Koehler, moved for denial of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Medlen, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

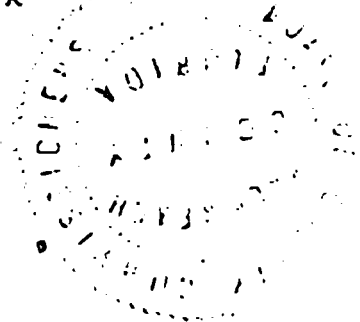
