

RESOLUTION NO. R-86-632

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 85-73, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the Governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 482.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 85-73 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on the 27th February 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 27th of February 1986, that Petition No. 65-73 the petition of DANIEL H. LEEVER By Kieran J. Kilday, Agent for the REZONING, FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT on the East 3/4 of the East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Section 36, Township 44 South, Range 41 East. Said property located on the north side of Lantana Road approximately 13.5 miles west of State Road 7 (U.S. 441) was approved as advertised.
