The North 10.0 feet of Lot 20, Block 2, lying West of Boutwell Road. The North 10.0 feet of Lot 20, Block 1. The West 5.0 feet of Lots 4 through 21 inclusive, Block 1, all being in DONORA PARK, according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book 13, Page 36, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

The West 5.0 feet of Lots 19 through 30, inclusive, Block 2. The South 10.0 feet of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 2. The East 5.0 feet of Lots 4 through 15 inclusive, Block 3, The South 10.0 feet of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 3 all being in WESTWORTH, according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book 13, Page 47, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

3. Notice of the adoption of this Resolution shall be published once in the Palm Beach Post Times within thirty (30) days of the date of adoption of this Resolution in accordance with Section 336.10, Florida Statutes and Ordinance No. 71-3.
