- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- 2. The following described right of way is hereby abandoned and closed as public right of way, and this Board does hereby renounce and disclaim any right or interest of Palm Beach County and the public in and to the following:

That portion of a 50 Foot Platted Right of Way Known as Tuscaloosa Street, as it lies between Yancy Avenue and Thelma Avenue, Shown on the Plat of CINQUEZ PARK, 2nd Addition, Recorded in Plat Book 21, Page 20 of the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

3. Notice of the adoption of this Resolution shall be published one in the Palm Beach Post/Times within thirty (30) days of the date of acordance with Section 336.10, Florida Statutes, and Ordinance No. 71-3.
