A certain 10 foot Utility Easement along with the rear of Lots 1 through 44 of Block 2 of the Plat of Lakes of Sherbrooke, Phase III, as recorded in Plat Book 41, pages 46-48, incl., Pubic Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

3. Notice of the adoption of this Resolution shall be published once in the Palm Beach Post Times within thirty (30) days of the date of adoption of this Resolution in accordance with §336.10, Florida Statutes and Ordinance No. 71-3.
