CONTRACT FOR ACCESS TO TAVIS

This contract is made between the Office of the Tax Collector, Palm Beach County, hereinafter referred to as Tax Collector, and _____, hereinafter referred to as Business.

Whereas, the Tax Collector has installed a telephone activated vehicle information system which allows direct access to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (DHSMV) FRVIS system to participating dealers, companies and businesses on the conditions and terms set forth in this contract.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree to the following:

- 1) The Tax Collector and the Business agree to adhere to the policies, procedures, operating instructions and applicable laws and regulations issued by the DHSMV with regard to FRVIS access.
 - 2) The Tax Collector will provide an access code to the Business which will be used to access the system.
 - 3) The Business acknowledges and agrees that the use of the access code assigned to it and its personnel is confidential and is restricted to the use of the Business and its designated employees and further agrees to apply safeguards to maintain confidentiality of the access code so assigned. The Tax Collector will receive a report detailing all inquiries made to fulfill statutory requirements.
 - 4) The Business agrees to notify the Tax Collector within three(3) working days, in writing, of the termination of any of its employees who have been privy to the access code or of any misuse or unauthorized use of the access code. Failure to comply with this provision will result in the termination of this contract and the cancellation of all codes.
 - 5) Any violation of the Florida Statutes, Chapter 319 and 320, by the Business will be a violation of the conditions of this contract.
 - 6) The Tax Collector will not be liable in the event access to the FRVIS is unavailable due to inoperability, failure of equipment, or misuse of the access code by the Business, or for any other cause.

7) The annual fee is non refundable. This contract expires on September 30, of each year and all future renewal notices will become an addendum to this contract.

8) The application for access to the system, PBCTC Form 82, is attached and will be a part of this contract.

9) This contract may be terminated by the Tax Collector at the discretion of the Tax Collector.

- 13 With written consent of individual to whom the information pertains to.
- 14 If specifically authorized by a state
- 15 For resale of a DPPA permitted use, excluding 11 & 12.

I have read and understand Florida Statute 119.07(6)(aa) and I certify that any use of all information provided by the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles through the Tax Collector, Palm Beach County's TAVIS will be subject to the TAVIS contract and is allowable under the provisions of the law as indicated above. This certification shall apply to each and every record accessed through the Tax Collector, Palm Beach County's TAVIS. If the nature of my business or the permissible use change, it is my responsibility to contact the Tax Collector and complete a new TAVIS contract and Electronic Records User Registration or notify the Tax Collector of termination. This certification form cannot be changed or modified without the express prior written permission of the Tax Collector.

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Florida Statute (119.07(6)(aa), 1-15, F.S.):

(aa) Personal information contained in a motor vehicle record that identifies the subject of that record is exempt from subsection (1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution except as provided in this paragraph. Personal information includes, but is not limited to, the subject's social security number, driver identification number, name, address, telephone number, and medical or disability information. For purposes of this paragraph, personal information does not include information relating to vehicular crashes, driving violations, and driver's status. For purposes of this paragraph, "motor vehicle record" means any record that pertains to a motor vehicle operator's permit, motor vehicle title, motor vehicle registration, or identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles. Personal information contained in motor vehicle records exempted by this paragraph shall be released by the department for any of the following uses:

1. For use in connection with matters of motor vehicle or driver safety and theft; motor vehicle emissions; motor vehicle product alterations, recalls, or advisories; performance monitoring of motor vehicles and dealers by motor vehicle manufacturers; and removal of non-owner records from the original owner records of motor vehicle manufacturers, to carry out the purposes of the Automobile Information Disclosure Act, the Motor Vehicle Information and Cost Saving Act, the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966, the Anti-Car Theft Act of 1992, and the Clean Air Act.
 2. For use by any government agency, including any court or law enforcement agency, in carrying out its functions, or any private person or entity acting on behalf of a federal, state, or local agency in carrying out its functions.
 3. For use in connection with matters of motor vehicle or driver safety and theft; motor vehicle emissions; motor vehicle product alterations, recalls, or advisories; performance monitoring of motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts, and dealers; motor vehicle market research activities, including survey research; and removal of non-owner records from the original owner records of motor vehicle manufacturers.
 4. For use in the normal course of business by a legitimate business or its agents, employees, or contractors, but only:
 - a. To verify the accuracy of personal information submitted by the individual to the business or its agents, employees, or contractors; and
 - b. If such information as so submitted is not correct or is no longer correct, to obtain the correct information, but only for the purposes of preventing fraud by, pursuing legal remedies against, or recovering on a debt or security interest against, the individual.
 5. For use in connection with any civil, criminal, administrative, or arbitral proceeding in any court or agency or before any self-regulatory body for:
 - a. Service of process by any certified process server, special process server, or other person authorized to serve process in this state.
 - b. Investigation in anticipation of litigation by an attorney licensed to practice law in this state or the agent of the attorney; however, the information may not be used for mass commercial solicitation of clients for litigation against motor vehicle dealers.
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- c. Investigation by any person in connection with any filed proceeding; however, the information may not be used for mass commercial solicitation of clients for litigation against motor vehicle dealers.
 - d. Execution or enforcement of judgments and orders.
 - e. Compliance with an order of any court.
6. For use in research activities and for use in producing statistical reports, so long as the personal information is not published, re-disclosed, or used to contact individuals.
 7. For use by any insurer or insurance support organization, or by a self-insured entity, or its agents, employees, or contractors, in connection with claims investigation activities, anti-fraud activities, rating, or underwriting.
 8. For use in providing notice to the owners of towed or impounded vehicles.
 9. For use by any licensed private investigative agency or licensed security service for any purpose permitted under this paragraph. Personal information obtained based on an exempt driver's record may not be provided to a client who cannot demonstrate a need based on a police report, court order, or a business or personal relationship with the subject of the investigation.
 10. For use by an employer or its agent or insurer to obtain or verify information relating to a holder of a commercial driver's license that is required under 49 U.S.C. ss. 31301 et seq.
 11. For use in connection with the operation of private toll transportation facilities.
 12. For bulk distribution for surveys, marketing, or solicitations when the department has obtained the express consent of the person to whom such personal information pertains.
 13. For any use if the requesting person demonstrates that he or she has obtained the written consent of the person who is the subject of the motor vehicle record.
 14. For any other use specifically authorized by state law, if such use is related to the operation of a motor vehicle or public safety.
 15. For any other use if the person to whom the information pertains has given express consent on a form prescribed by the department. Such consent shall remain in effect until it is revoked by the person on a form prescribed by the department.
