

Attention Vessel Owners

Annual vessel registration fees will increase on July 1, 2008.

Vessel owners, like vehicle owners, must renew their annual registration by midnight of their birthday. The Tax Collector encourages clients to take advantage of the three-month early renewal option. Vessel owners with birthdays in July, August, or September may renew now.

County Fee:

Retained by the county where the vessel is registered. Counties that charge this fee are: Broward, Charlotte, Collier, Dade, Hillsborough, Lee, Manatee, Monroe, Palm Beach, Pinellas, Polk, Sarasota and Volusia.

Commercial Fee:

An additional \$50 commercial vessel license fee is required of all non-residents or aliens unless specifically exempted by statute.
