# **Summer Camp Scholarship Program**

#### **POLICY**

The SCSP is a public initiative providing a summer camp experience to children residing in Palm Beach County. Families whose income is at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines are eligible to apply for a Summer Camp scholarship. Summer Camp scholarships will be awarded in order of accurately completed application based on the following eligibility criteria.

### **CRITERIA:**

- 1. Homeless, Foster Care involved, DJJ involved, Bridges Summer Reading Program
- 2. Children of full-time working parents (minimum of 32 hours per week)
- 3. Children and/or parent with special needs receiving social security benefits
- 4. Children of part-time working parents (parents working 25 to 31 hours per week)
- 5. Children who are in the legal custody of their grandparents or other family members (must provide custody documents as noted in the parent eligibility)
- 6. Children of OEF and OIF (must provide documentation of parent deployment/service)
- 7. Children of parents who are full-time students (ongoing, certificate/ degree seeking 12 credits or more, must provide enrollment document)
- 8. Any other child whose family meets the income guidelines

### **Specialized populations**

Homeless, Foster Care, DJJ and siblings, and Bridges Summer Reading Program (SRP)

- 1. Eligibility for homeless is based on definition established in glossary of terms
- 2. Children must be a Palm Beach County resident and meet age guidelines (5-17)
