Chapter 12, Section 1, Code of Ethics

- D. Per Article XII, Section 2-422, Palm Beach County Code, the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) was established in 2010 to "Enhance Public Trust in Government". The OIG has complete independent oversight authority at both County and Municipal levels to ensure accountability and transparency to the citizens of Palm Beach County. Village employees who wish to report mismanagement of contracts, fraud, theft, bribery, or other violations of the law which appear to fall within the jurisdiction of the OIG, shall notify their supervisor, department head, Village Manager, or the OIG. The Village Manager shall notify the inspector general of the aforementioned possible violations.
